What's NEW?

Arlington Public Schools (APS) encourages and supports the work of volunteers in many areas of instruction to assist and enrich the learning for all

students at all levels. The Code of Virginia requires that volunteers and staff in schools must complete training on this important topic to safeguard the well-being of our children. To ensure the safety of our students, APS has selected **Safe Schools** to provide online training on the topic of sexual misconduct. The **Safe Schools** training is easy to complete and fulfills the state requirement.

The training is provided online and you will have 30 days to complete. You will receive a link to your email address. Once you complete the training, **Safe Schools** will let us know that you have completed the training and will email your results directly to you. If you need access to a computer, your Volunteer and Partner Liaison can assist you with that when you are at the school — just ask!
