#### **CIP Process**



- FY 2017-26 CIP addresses projected seat needs through 2025-26 School Year.
- Every 2 years CIP is revised and updated.
- All future APS CIPs:
  - New available space opportunities will be incorporated.
  - Funding scenarios will be updated.
  - ✓ Plans will reflect updated enrollment projections.



#### **CIP Overview**



- FY 2017-26 CIP no plans for extreme measures included to relieve crowding:
  - ✓ No double shifts of class schedules for HS Students
  - ✓ No required out-of-school internships
  - ✓ No expansion of digital classes
- All High School Students (current & future) will have full access to athletics and extra-curricular activities.

### **Arlington Science Focus**



- Planning underway to determine the feasibility and cost of internal modifications at Arlington Science Focus
- Funding sources to be determined
- Four classrooms (est. 93 seats) not counted in seat status on previous slides





#### **Community Engagement Processes**



- Arlington Tech: planning and phasing study
- High Schools: visioning process
- High Schools: boundary refinement process
- Middle Schools: boundary change process for new MS at Stratford site
- Elementary Schools: boundary change process for new ES at Jefferson site
- Drew Neighborhood School: visioning process
- Aurora Hills Community & Senior Center: planning study with Arlington County for joint-use redevelopment



## **HS Boundary Refinements**



If boundary refinements take effect **September 2017 to balance enrollment** among Wakefield, Washington-Lee and Yorktown:

- Only incoming and future 9<sup>th</sup> graders reassigned
- Up to 100 students total reassigned the first year
- Community engagement process September to early November 2016
- Process will include review of SB Policy 25-2.2 (Enrollment and Transfers for Schools and Programs) for IB and other admissions procedures



#### **Summary**



- CIP plans for projected seat needs through 2025-26 School Year.
- Addresses greatest need at high school level by providing over 2,800 seats.
- Addresses elementary need by providing over 1,100 seats.
- New MS at Stratford, Wilson site project, and new ES at Jefferson remain in CIP to be completed in 2019 as scheduled.
- Reed project ES is advanced to open 2021 with assistance of County.
- High school visioning process will take place during 2016-17 school year to define requirements and configurations that will define future of Arlington Tech and the Career Center, and other high school seats to be provided, most likely in place of the Education Center.
