APS students:


- Have access to opportunities and choices that create a successful future

Our Challenge





- H.S. enrollment projections show steady growth
- The CIP outlines a plan to add more seats to increase H.S. capacity
- Boundary refinements provide another tool to help us address our space needs

Our Boundary Refinement Goals



- Because APS is growing, refinements will help us adjust and respond to continued growth
- Boundary refinements will enable:
 - balanced enrollment among the 3 APS comprehensive high schools
 - better utilization of available and planned instructional spaces

NOTE: We may need to revisit H.S. boundaries as we prepare to add 1,300 H.S. seats in 2022



APS Boundary Policy (30-2.2)



. . . recommended boundary changes . . . shall include, but not be limited to, consideration of the the following criteria:

- Efficiency
- Proximity
- Stability

- Alignment
- Demographics
- Contiguity



H.S. Boundary Refinements



Recommendations:

- Will take effect September 2017
- Will apply to current grade 8 students incoming freshman class of 2017-18 (class of '21) and future freshman classes
- Will not apply to students who are already enrolled in high school
- Will include options for siblings of current high school students
- Will be communicated at High School Information Night on December 12, 2016



How do we refine high school boundaries to prepare for 2020? What's needed?










Projected H.S. Seats in 2020-21

If No Boundary Refinements Are Made








Proposed Planning Units
