MEETING MINUTES October 18, 2016 7:00 p.m. Career Center

- 1. Introduction: Greg Greeley, Chair, welcomed attendees to the meeting.
- 2. **School Bond Vote:** The FAC voted to endorse the school bond 10-0 with 3 abstentions.
- 3. Enrollment & Projections: Lionel White provided a document that described the methodology used by APS for school enrollment projections. He discussed the Grade Progression Ratio method and the Student Generation Factor method, which includes recently completed residential housing units, residential development projects currently under construction and residential development projects that are approved by the County but not yet under construction.
- 4. Policies & PIPs: John Chadwick noted that the Policies and Policy Implementation Procedures are required to be reviewed every 5 years. The School Board has asked that the FAC provide input to the staff as they update the Policies and the PIPs. Greg Greeley noted that he will solicit volunteers via e-mail to join a working group to review the Policies and PIPs.
- 5. **Update on Maintenance Projects:** John Chadwick noted that the staff had taken on too many maintenance projects over the summer for the current staff resources. He will be requesting a budget increase for additional maintenance staff to account for the increase in buildings and square footage that now needs to be maintained.
- 6. **Update on High School Boundary Refinements:** John Peck discussed the meetings held to date for the working group interested in high school boundaries.
- 7. **Methodology for Evaluating Community Input:** Lisa Stengle reviewed the staff's current thoughts on how to review planning unit information against the six criteria in the School Board's policy on boundary changes. She showed some structured approaches to listing, by planning unit, the potential impact on the various criteria.
