Notable Accomplishments

- All schools fully accredited by the Commonwealth
- Achieved 98.5% graduation rate for 3 comprehensive HS
- Dropout rate reduced by 65% since 2009
- 91% of graduates plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college
- 75% of graduates completed 1 or more college level courses (AP; IB; dual enrollment)
- Almost 69% of graduates earned an Advanced Studies diploma, a 12% increase since 2009
- 74% of 8th graders complete Algebra 1/Geometry

Enrollment

- Enrollment is now 709
 students (2.9%) more than last
 school year
- Over past 6 years enrollment has increased by 5,005 students (25%)
- In next 5 years enrollment is projected to increase by 4,318 more students (17%)








10 Year Enrollment Projections
