## Sibling Preference Challenge

Keep families together

- Grandfather currently enrolled students & their siblings

Sibling transfer meaning less if not neighborhood spots available

How can ASFS be a neighborhood school if kids in neighborhood not allowed to attend?

Splitting up siblings at elem level puts too great a burden on families who are stay-at-home parents. Getting 2-3 small children to different schools, different start times, etc.

need grandfather for sibling preference

Get rid of sibling preference in middle school

Keep siblings together for elementary students less independent

<sup>most</sup> Secondary students can handle being at different school from sibling. (My family managed. If sibs MUST stay together, they can choose their neighborhood school)

It is not fair to split siblings up at the elementary level. It is better to keep them together at the elementary level and let them go to different schools at the secondary level.
