- Submit an application to the school's Volunteer and Partnership (V&P) Liaison where you would like to volunteer. If you are interested in volunteering but need assistance finding a school to serve, please contact Dawn Smith at: dawn.smith@apsva.us

Once your application has been submitted to the V&P Liaison, a background check will be performed and you will be contacted directly when this is complete.

Before volunteering you need to sign a Confidentiality Agreement and complete the Safe Schools Training online. Finally, volunteer orientation will be conducted by the Volunteer and Partnership Liaison at the school where you requested to volunteer.
