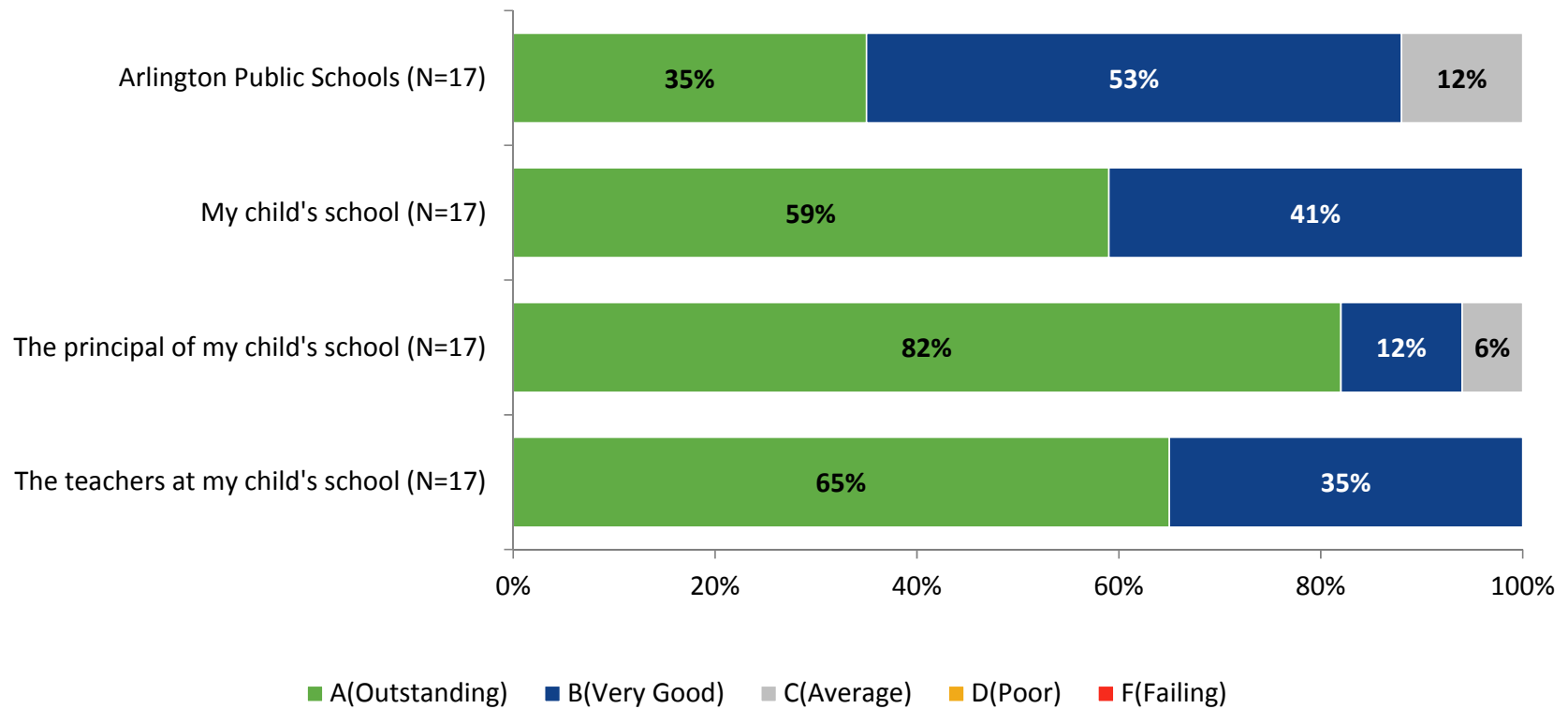

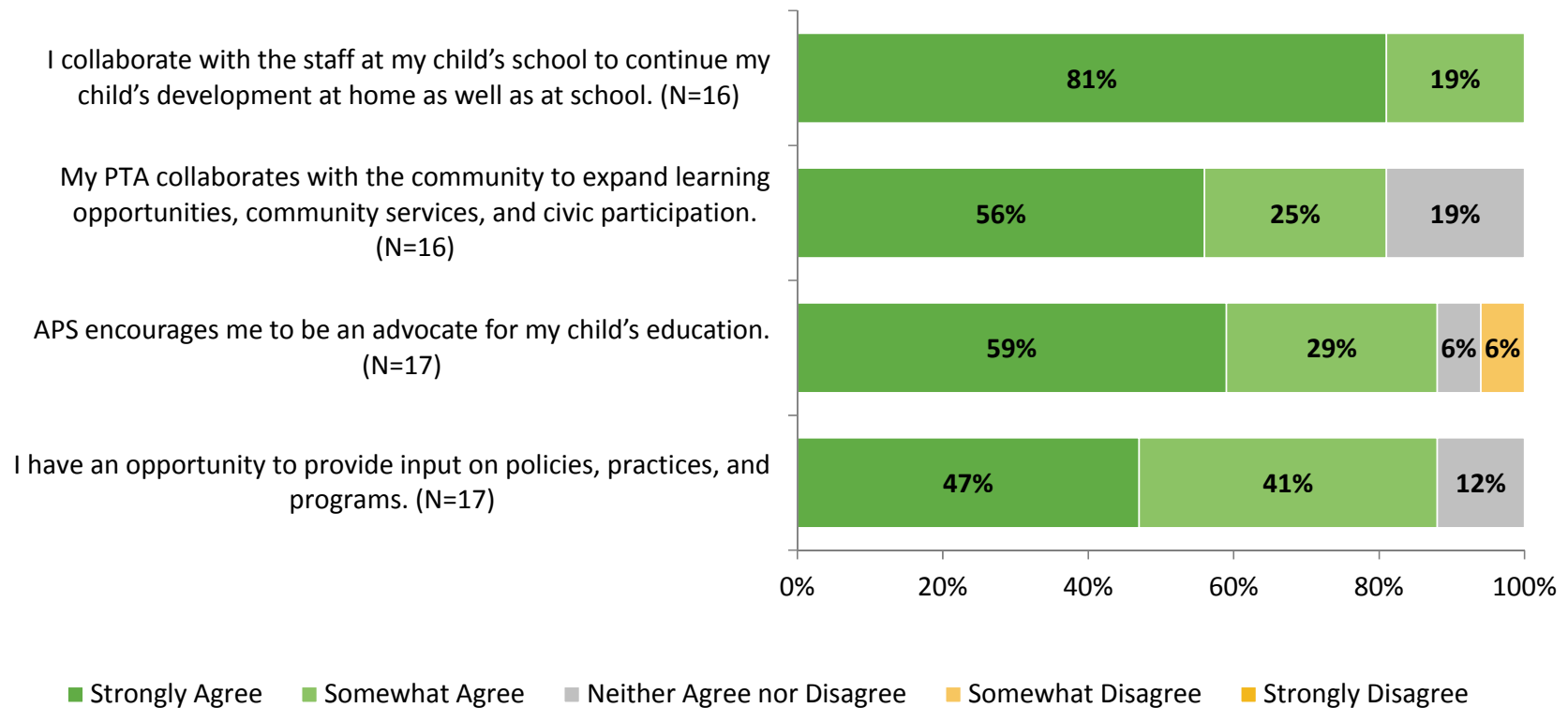

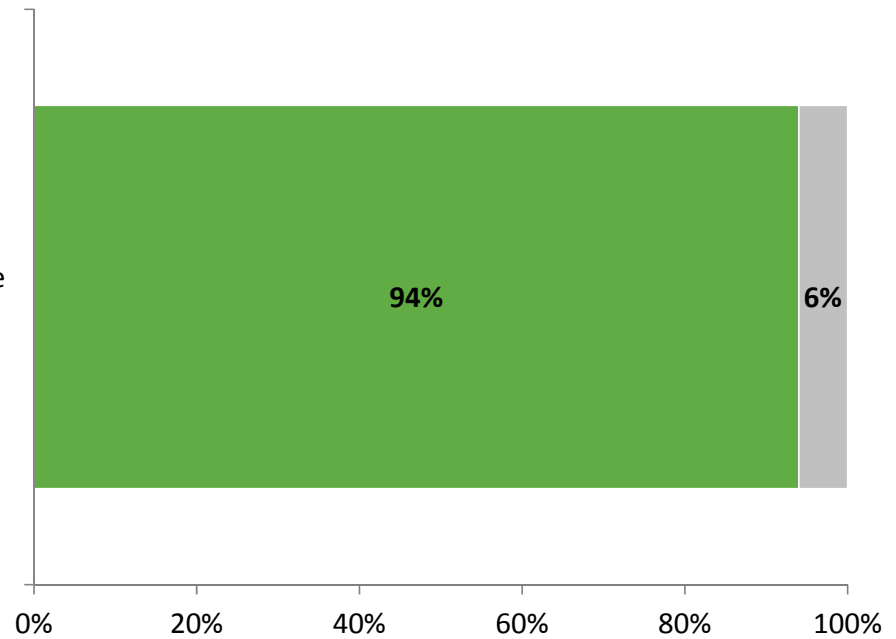

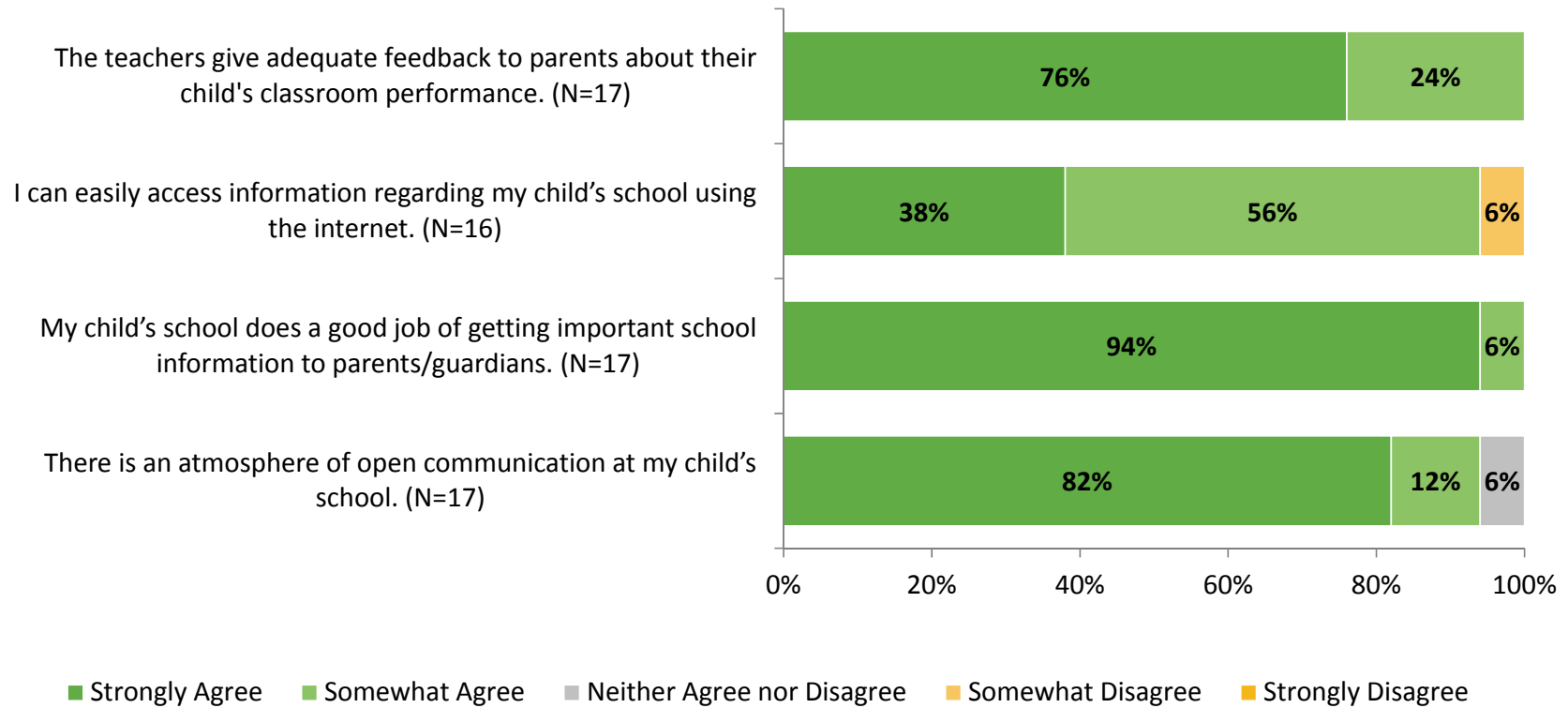
The principal is responsive to the concerns of parents and the community. (N=17)

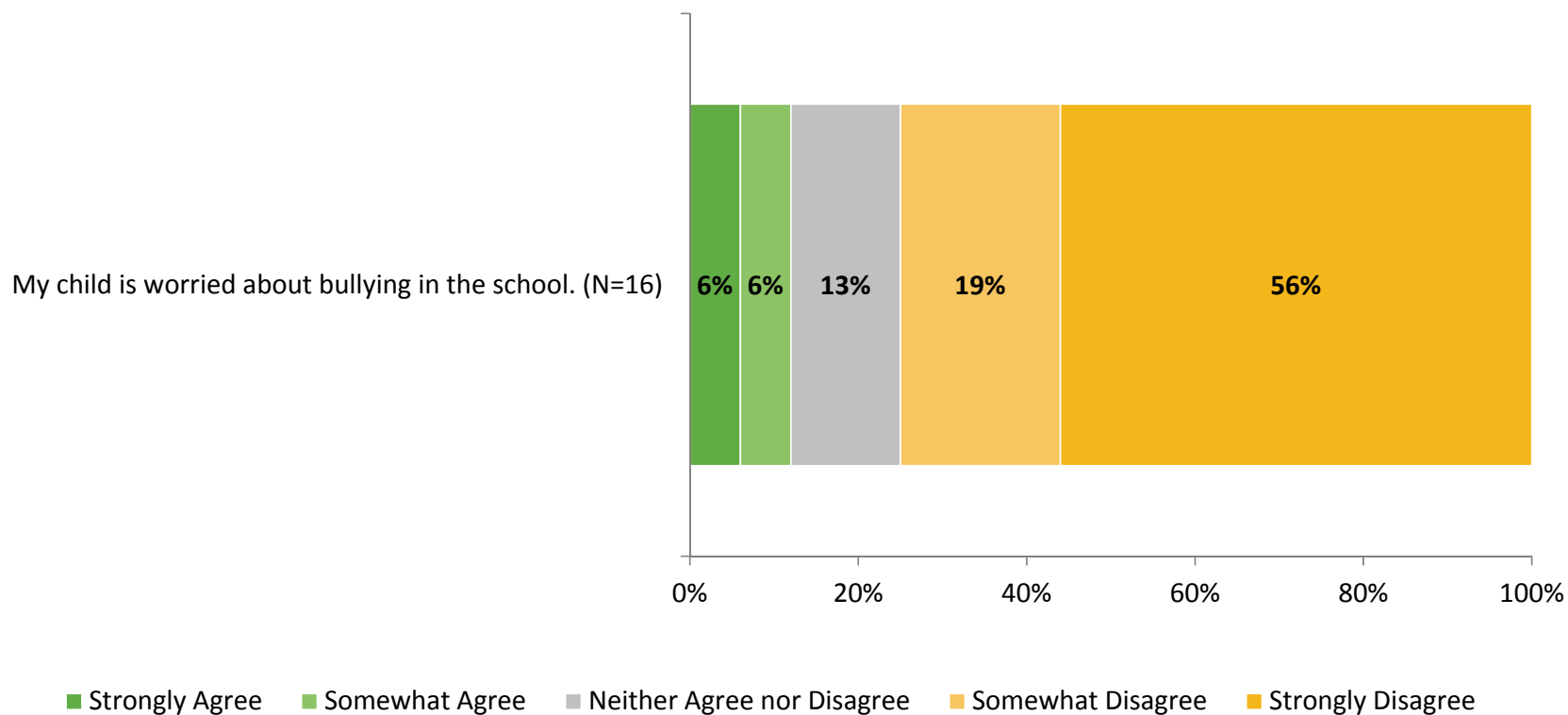

To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements?



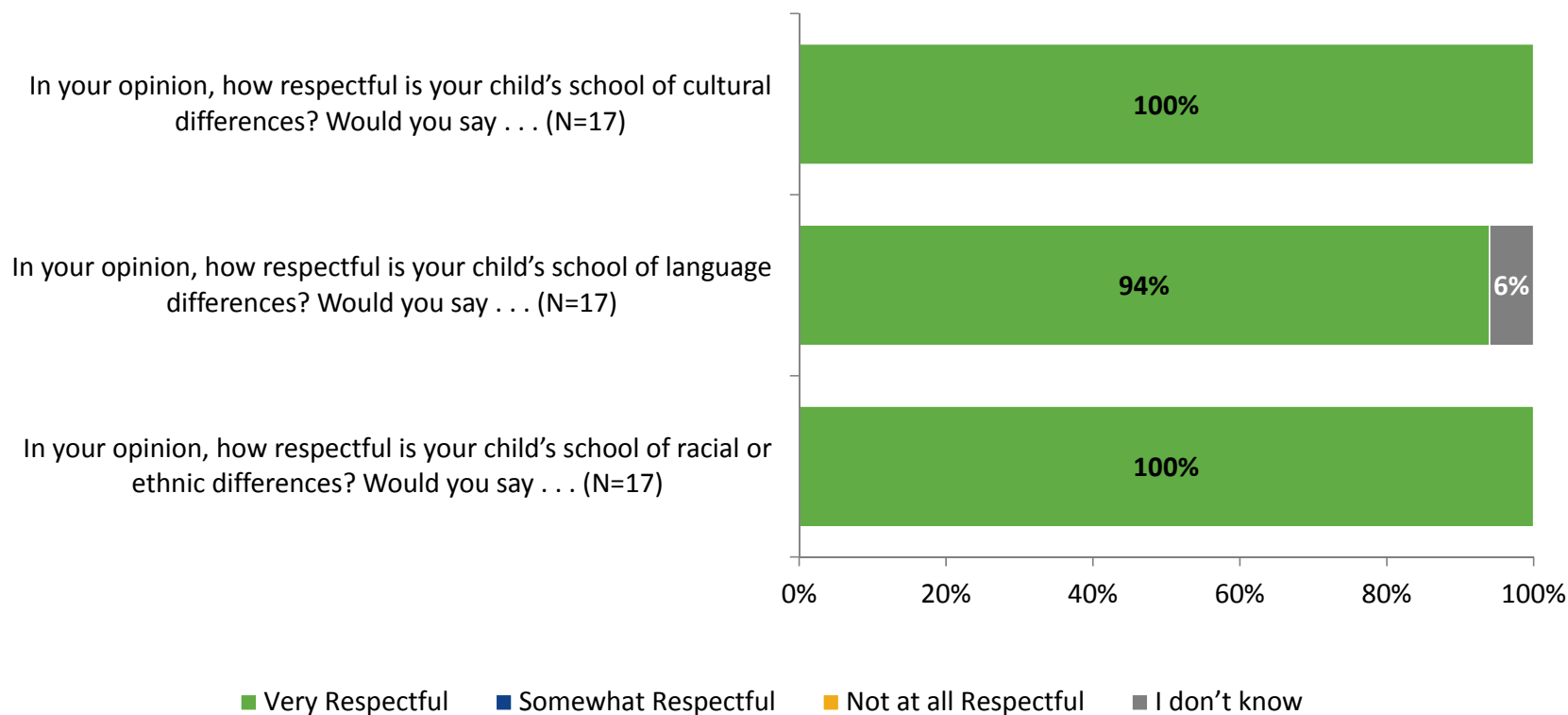

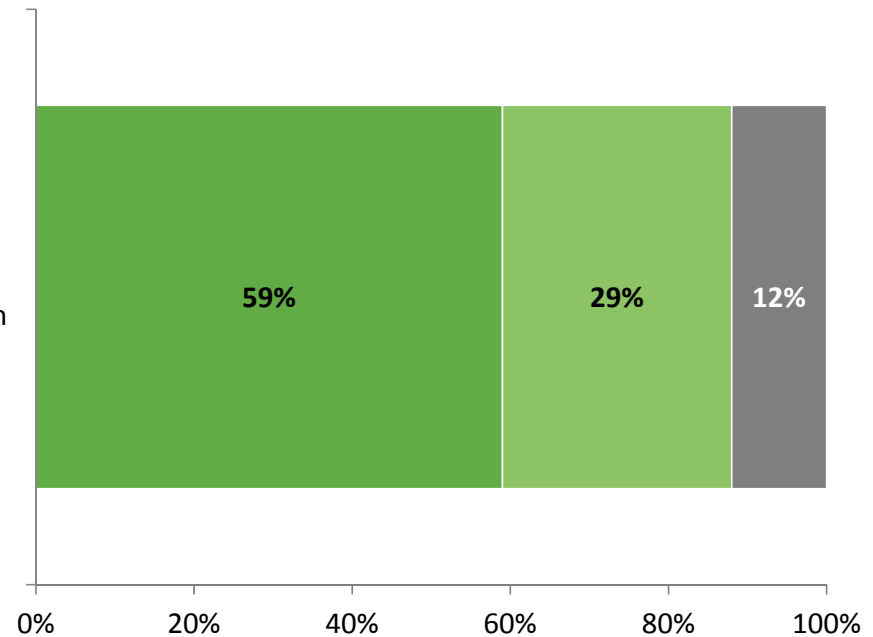

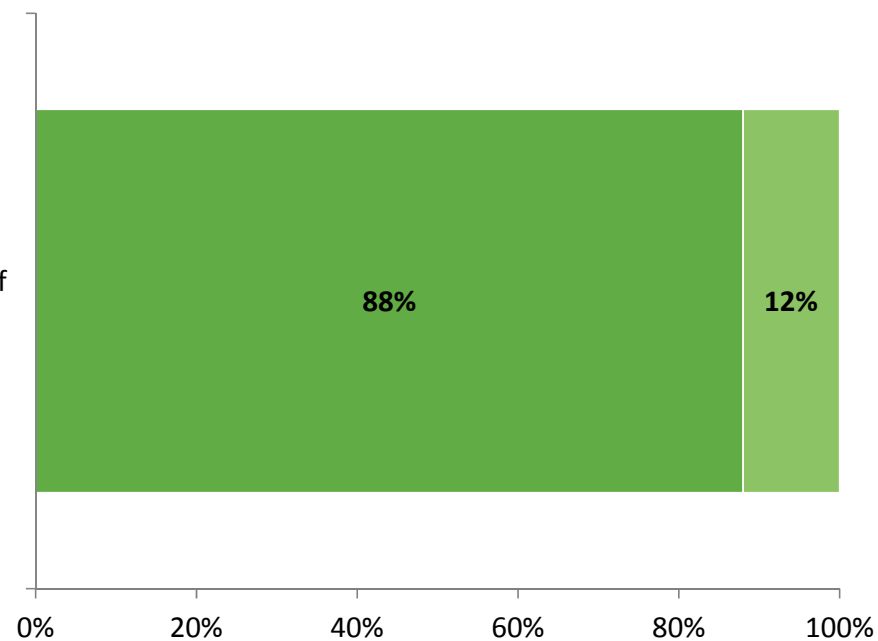
Black and Hispanic students generally score lower on standardized tests than White students. In your opinion, how important do you think it is to close this academic gap between these groups of students? (N=17)

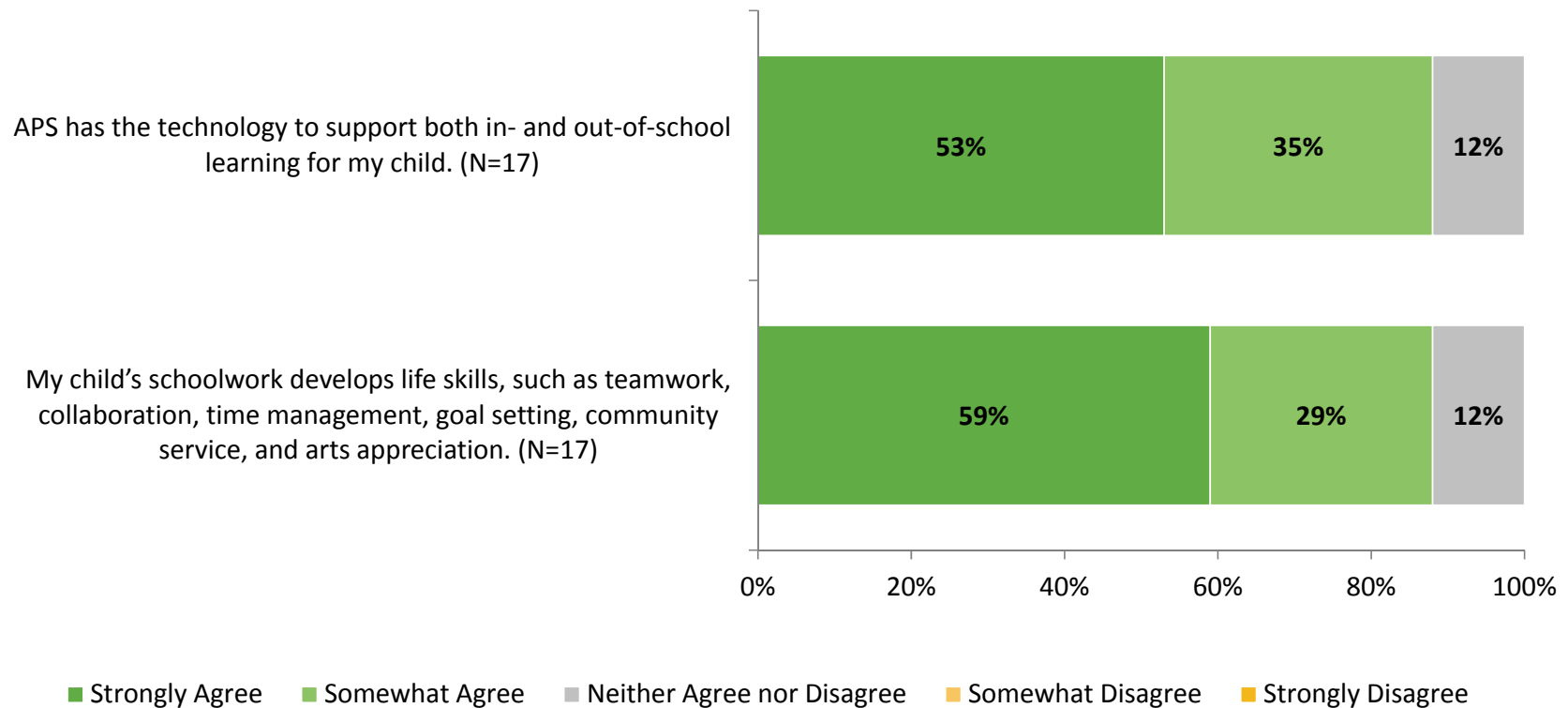
Please rate your level of satisfaction with the overall quality of instruction that your child is receiving. (N=17)

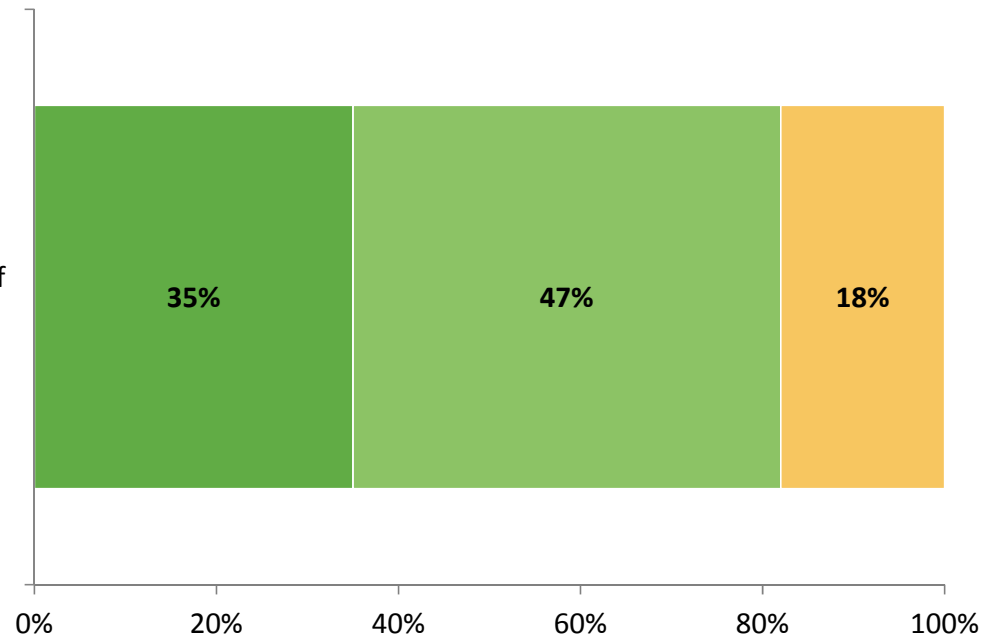

In your opinion, how challenging is the overall level of instruction your child is receiving? (N=17)

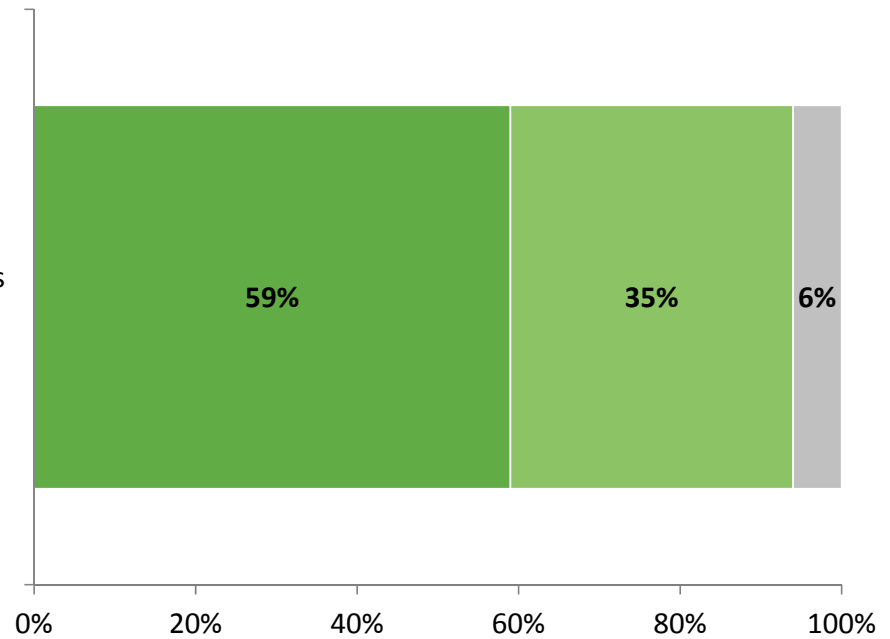

To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement?

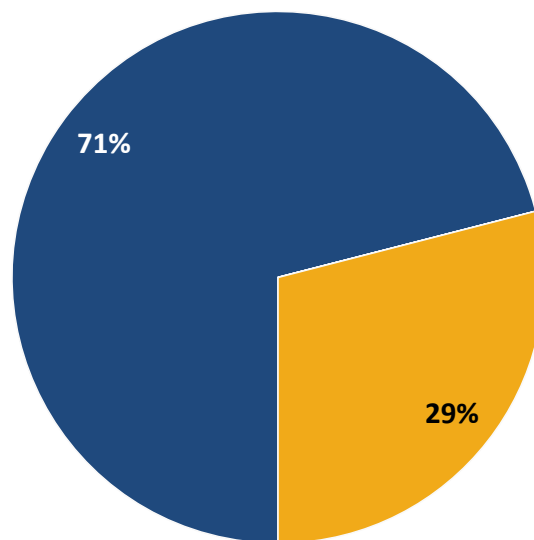
My child's teachers maintain consistent and high expectations for my child. (N=17)

How do you feel about the amount of time your child spends on homework? (N=14)

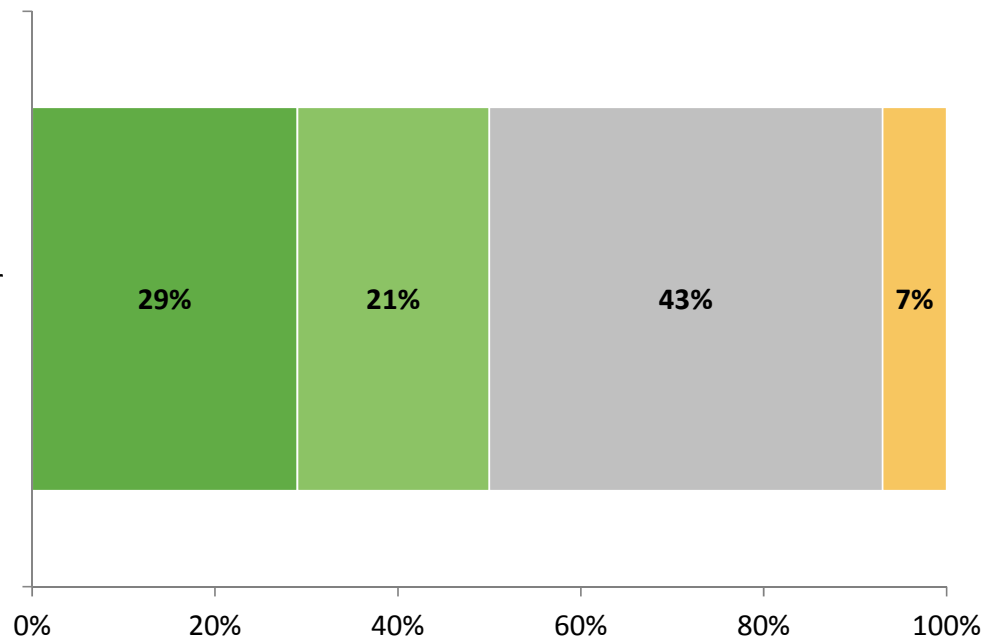

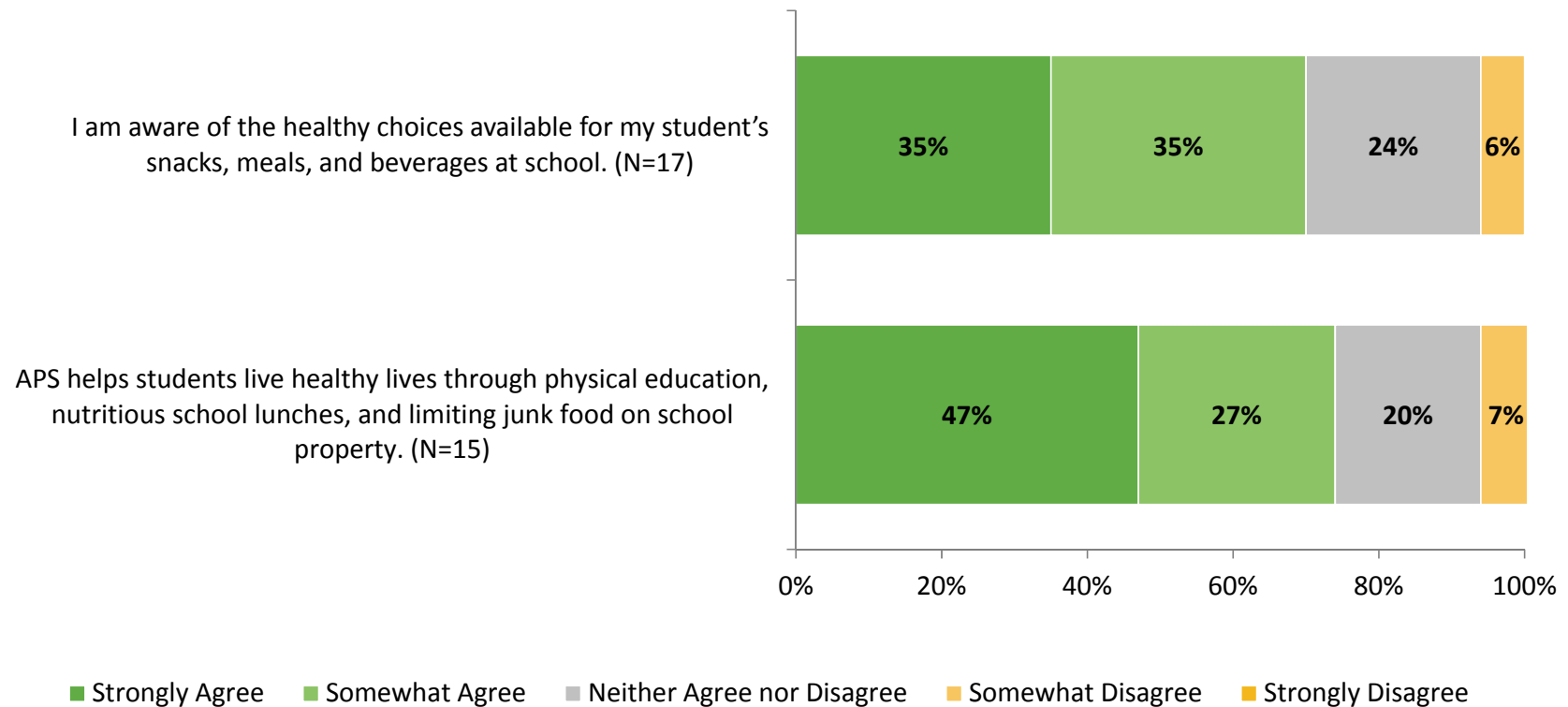

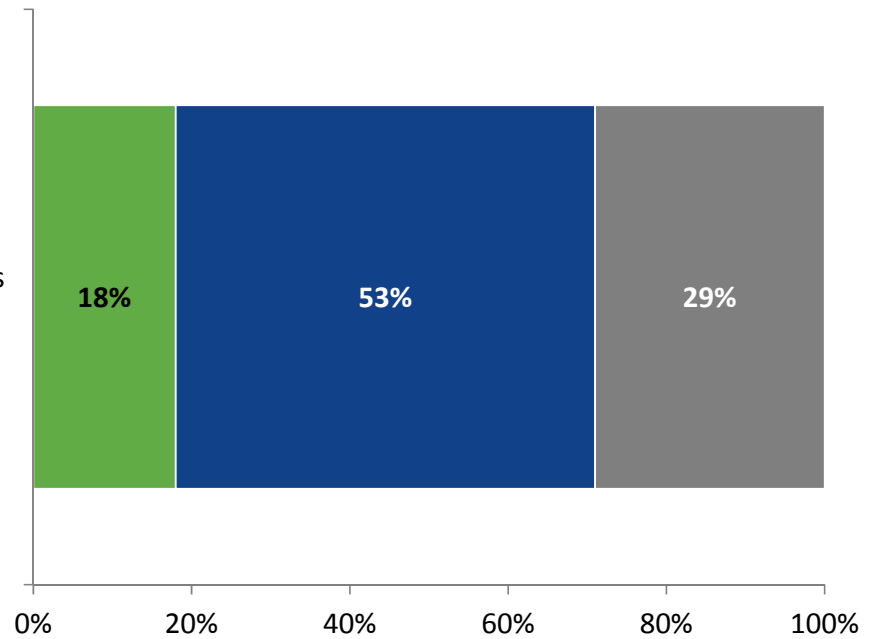

The amount of time my student spends doing physical activities in school has... (N=17)

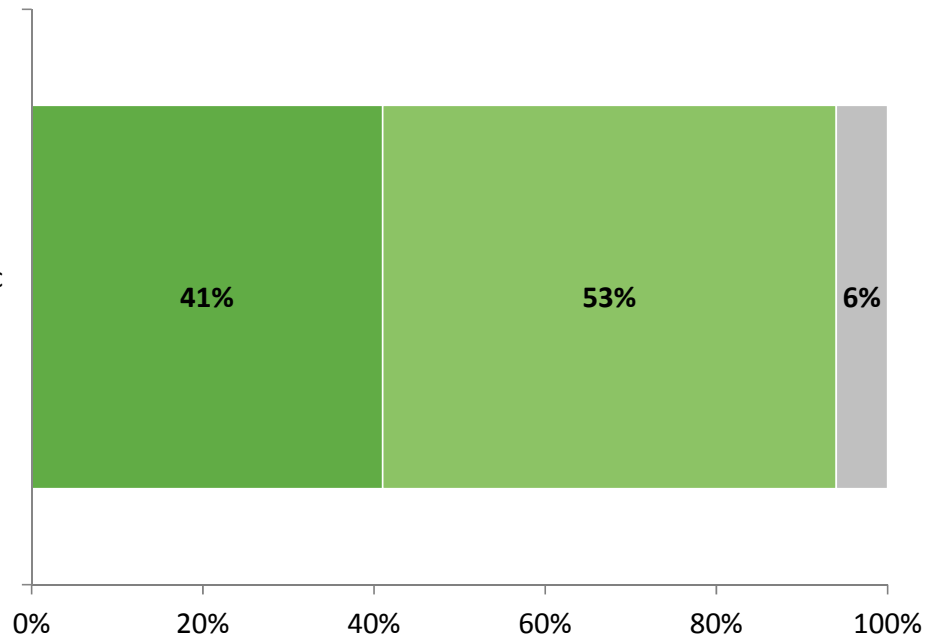

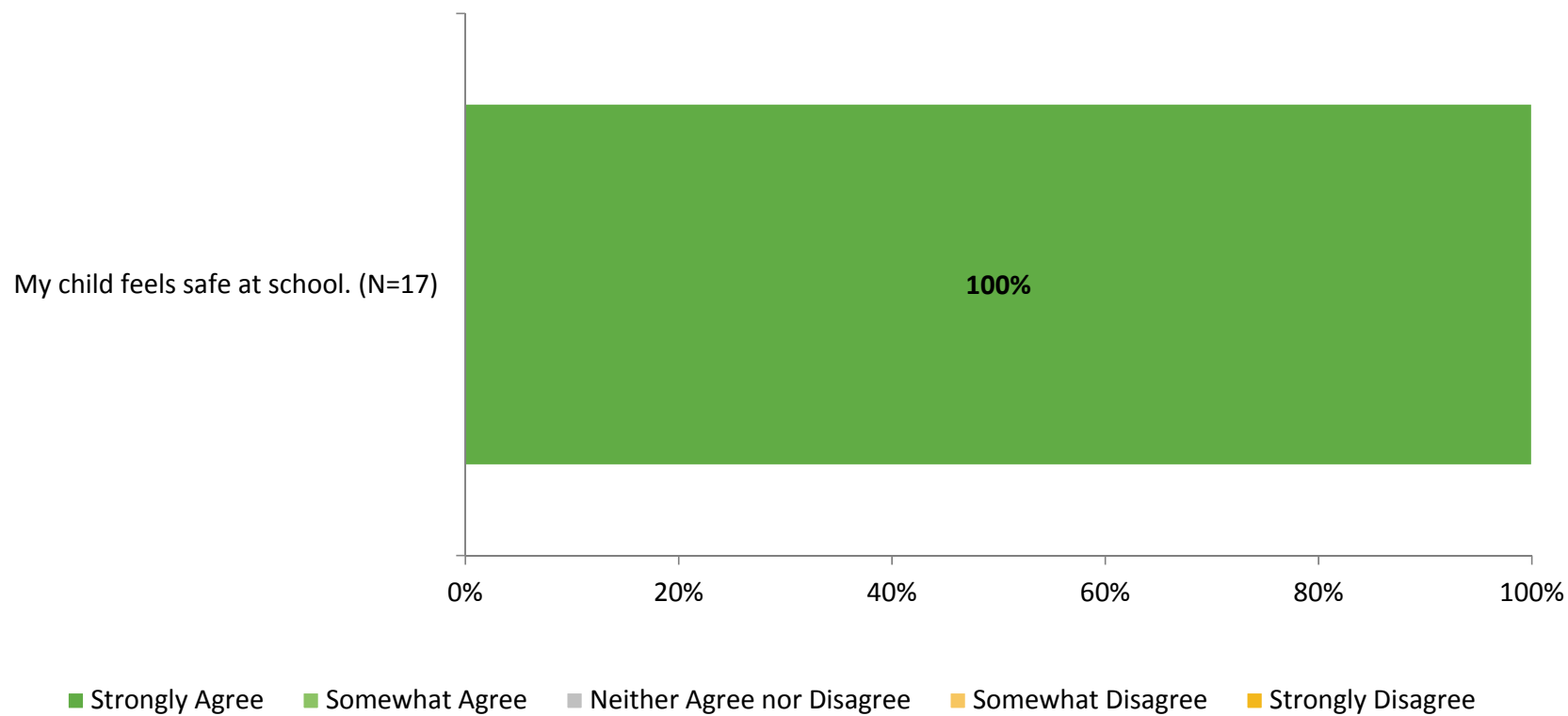
My tax dollars are being well spent by the Arlington Public School system. (N=17)

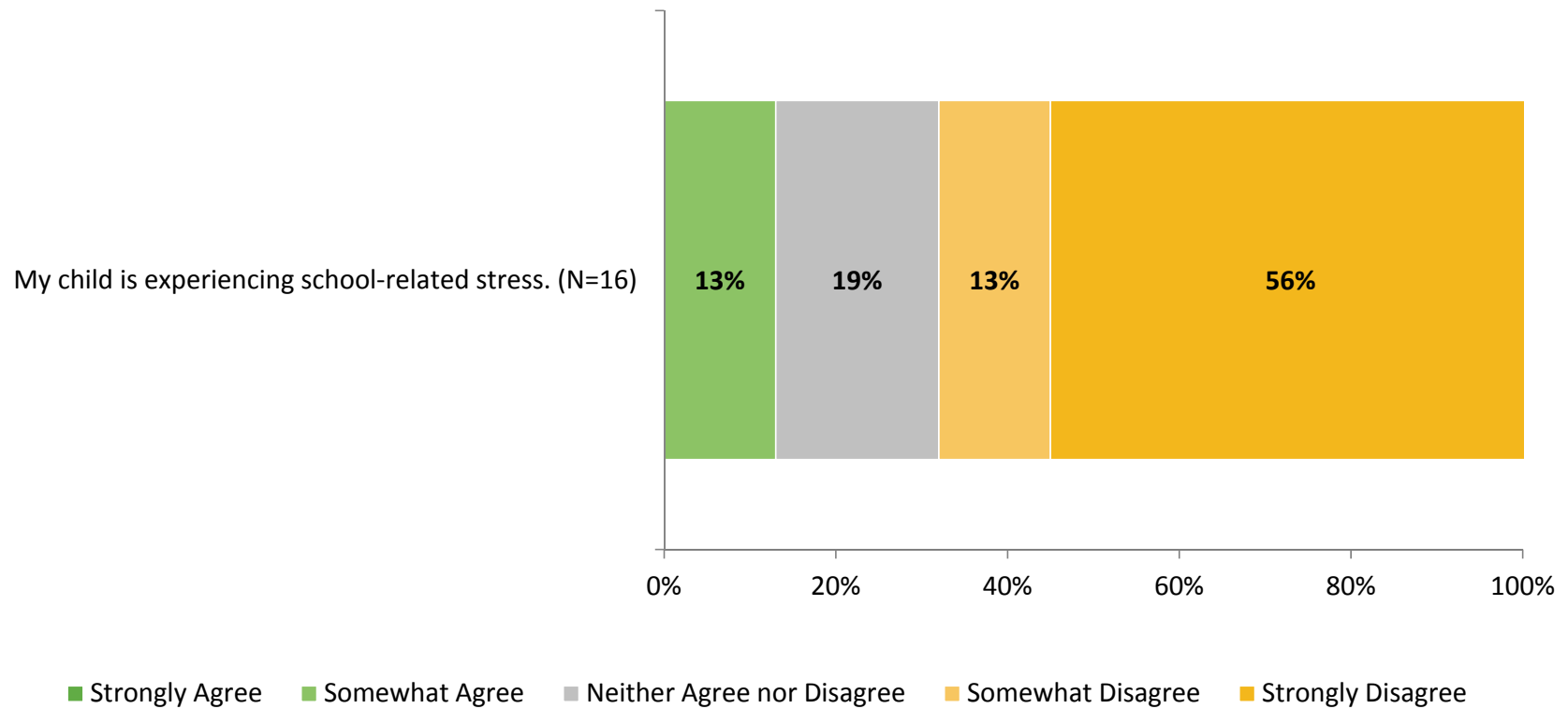

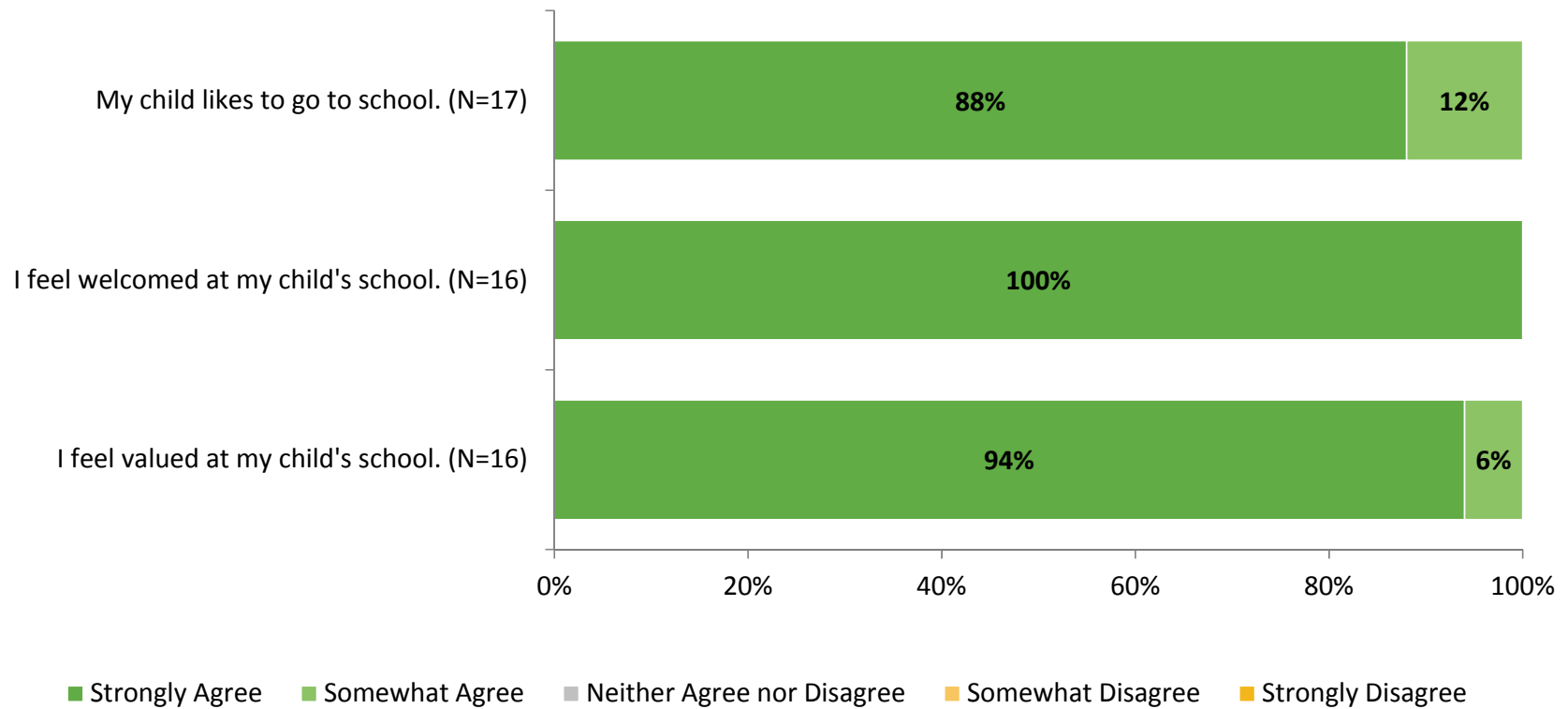

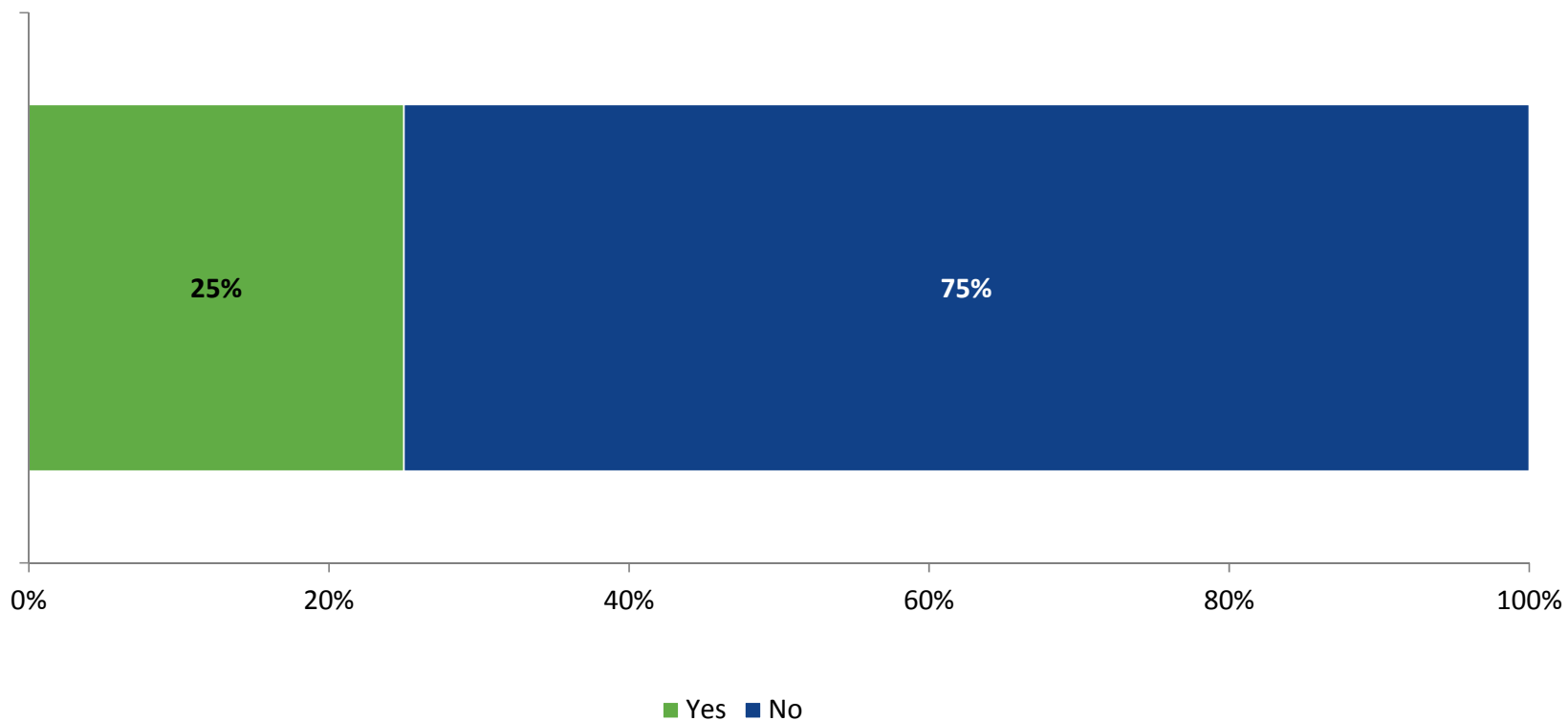

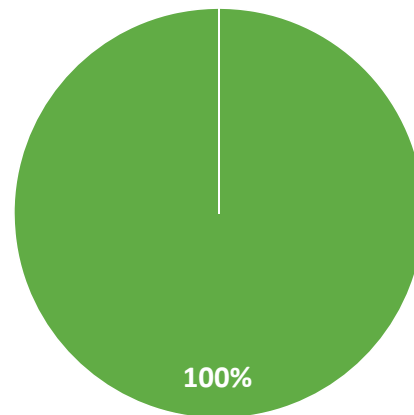
Breakfast Program
