Meeting with Advisory Council Leadership

Ms. Van Doren welcomed advisory members to a discussion about the FY 2018 Budget and the Superintendent's Proposed FY 2018 Budget tiered reductions. Committee members expressed their concern about class size increases, the effect of the President's proposed budget on the school system, and implementation of the personalized learning initiative. They also expressed their support of maintaining psychologists.

The Board took a brief recess at 7:30 p.m. and reconvened at 7:35 p.m.

Dr. Murphy outlined the agenda and topics for discussion such as spring enrollment changes, County revenue update, and School Board proposed changes to Superintendent's Proposed Budget.

Spring Enrollment Changes

Two changes in the spring enrollment projections are a decrease in student identification for special education due to the implementation of the Arlington Tiered System of Support (ATSS) and updates to the WIDA assessment for English language learner students.

County Update

Ms. Peterson informed the Board that there were no recent changes to the County revenue as the County Board continues the process of adopting their budget. Ms. Peterson reviewed three scenarios that would help close the APS budget gap based on the County's one-time funding and/or proposed tax rate increase.

Ms. Van Doren encouraged parents and community members to attend the County's public hearings to advocate the County Board to fund the APS budget.

School Board Proposed Change to Superintendent's Proposed Budget

The Board discussed putting forth a needs-based budget and did not propose changes at the work session. They spoke about prioritizing services that directly support students, creating efficiencies, and advocating to the County Board to fully fund the APS budget. The Board also discussed proposing tiered reductions based on the different budget gap scenarios.

Ms. Talento requested a follow-up from Dr. Murphy on the ratio of psychologists and social workers for this school year.
