Dr. Kanninen then led a discussion of the roles and responsibilities of the Board. In closing, Dr. Murphy reviewed the timeline for the plan, including identifying questions that the School Board will need to weigh in on as the plan goes forward. Ms. Van Doren thanked the group for their participation.
