


## DOES YOUR CHILD HAVE PUBLICLY-FUNDED INSURANCE?














- Medicaid, FAMIS: If your child receives SSI or is a new enrollee to Virginia State Medicaid or FAMIS, the child will have a Commonwealth of Virginia Department of Medical Assistance Services Card.
- Medicaid Medallion II: Most Medicaid eligible children get their care through a Managed Care Organization. There are different MCOs are available in different areas. Your choices are based on where you live. MCOs that provide health care to Medicaid children include: Amerigroup, Anthem, CareNet, Optima, and Virginia Premier
- FAMIS, FAMIS PLUS: Children enrolled in FAMIS Plus also get a card, and most are then enrolled in a MCO just like the Medicaid Medallion II coverage. The managed care organization may issue their own insurance card that is used when visiting the doctor.

If your child receives health insurance benefits in any of the ways shown, we will ask your permission (consent) to bill Medicaid so Arlington Public Schools can be reimbursed for providing your child with medically-related special education school services.
