





Indicator 2 SWD in grades 7-12 who dropped out










Indicator 5b Percent of SWD Included in the Regular Classroom Less Than 40% of the Day






Indicator 6a Sts aged 3-5 who spend the majority of their time in the regular early childhood program













Indicator 7b2 PreK acquisition & use of knowledge & skills percent functioning within age expectations


