Evaluation Process

2017-18

- Publish RFP
- Select contractor

2018-19

- Contractor works with APS to collect data
- Contractor reports findings and recommendations





Program Evaluation Goals

- Spur continuous improvement of outcomes
- Ensure the effective use of resources
- Facilitate effective decision-making
- Hold staff, students, schools, departments, programs, and the school system accountable for their contributions to the achievement of these aims





Opportunities for Input

RFP Process

- December 4: Meeting
 - School, central staff
 - County staff
 - ASEAC reps
- Meeting participants casting a wider net for input
- "Shortlist interviews," provide input into selection of contractor

Next Year: TBD in collaboration with selected contractor





Evaluation Questions

- Overarching questions about experiences of students with special needs in APS
- Multiple data sources will answer questions.
 Examples:
 - Assessments
 - Classroom observations
 - Interviews, surveys, focus groups
 - Document reviews
- Evaluation questions are not survey questions






Evaluation Questions

Source of draft questions:

- Prior evaluation's RFP
- Discussion with Special Education, Student Services, and ATSS about what's missing
- Borrowed from ESOL/HILT evaluation
- As you review questions, consider:
 - Does data exist that can answer the question?
 - If not, will a contractor be able to collect data to answer the question?





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
