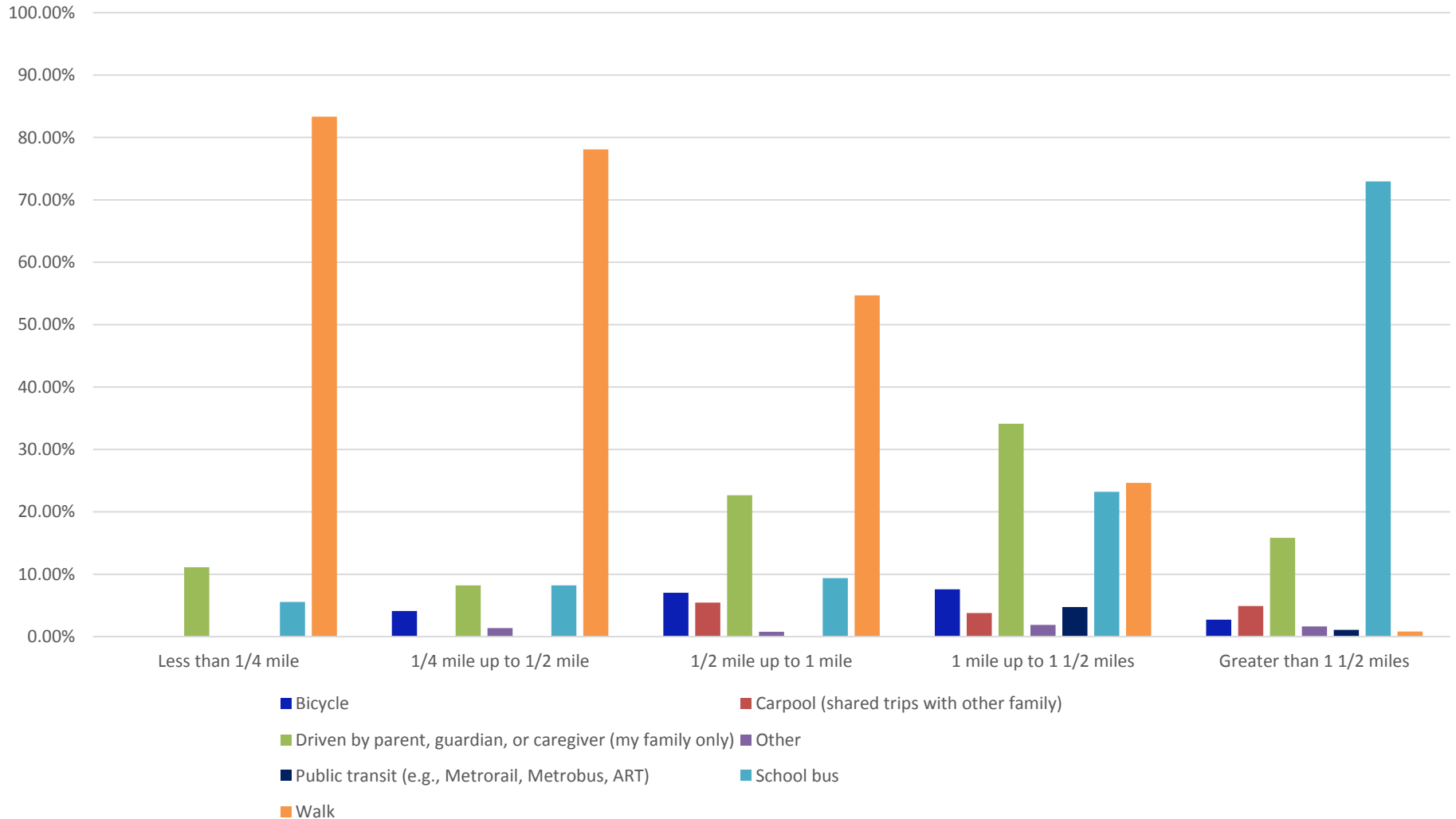

...Trying to avoid the third condition in school areas



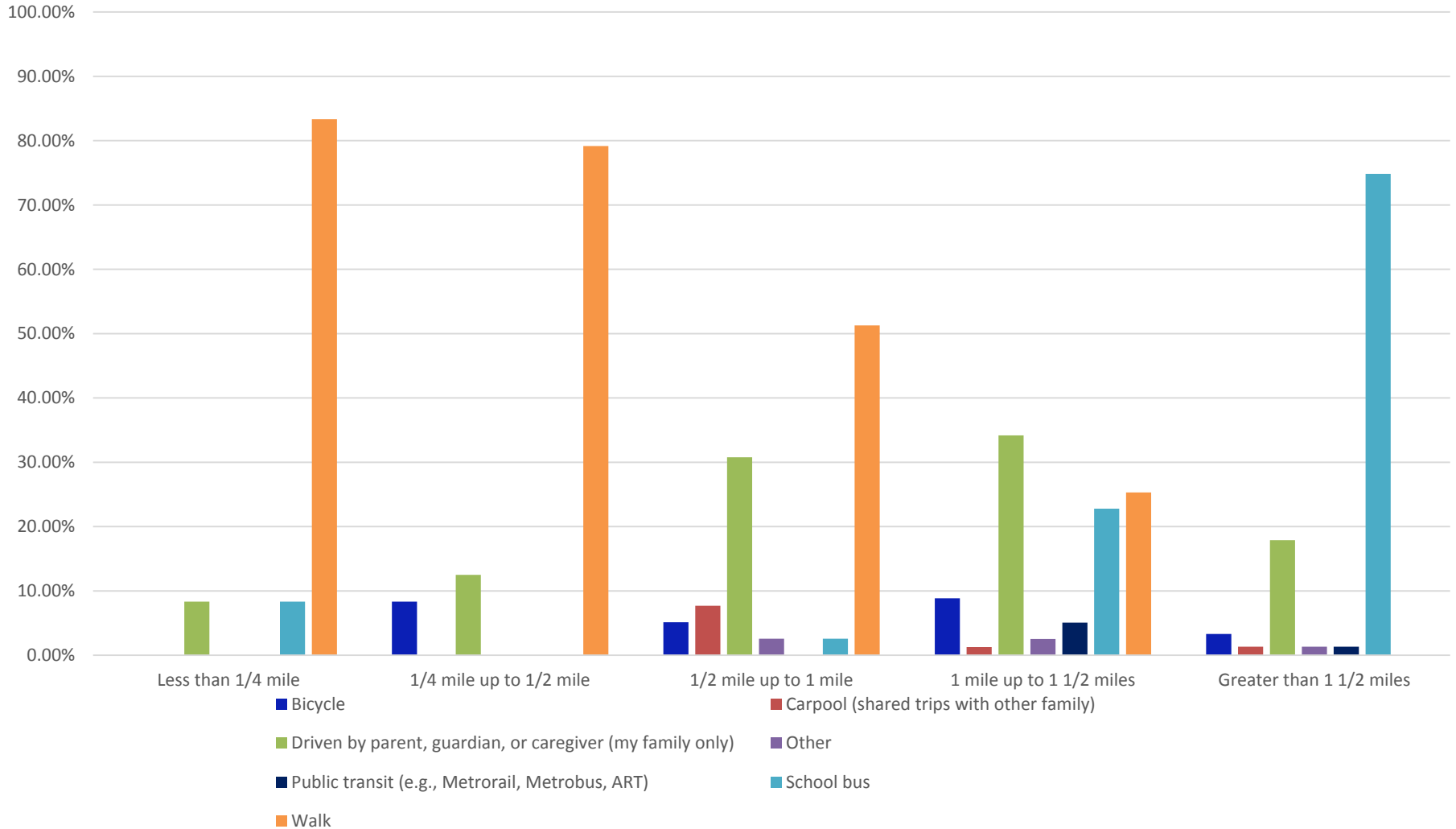
Where Does Walking Occur?

Grades 6-10 (APSGo! 2016 Parent Survey)



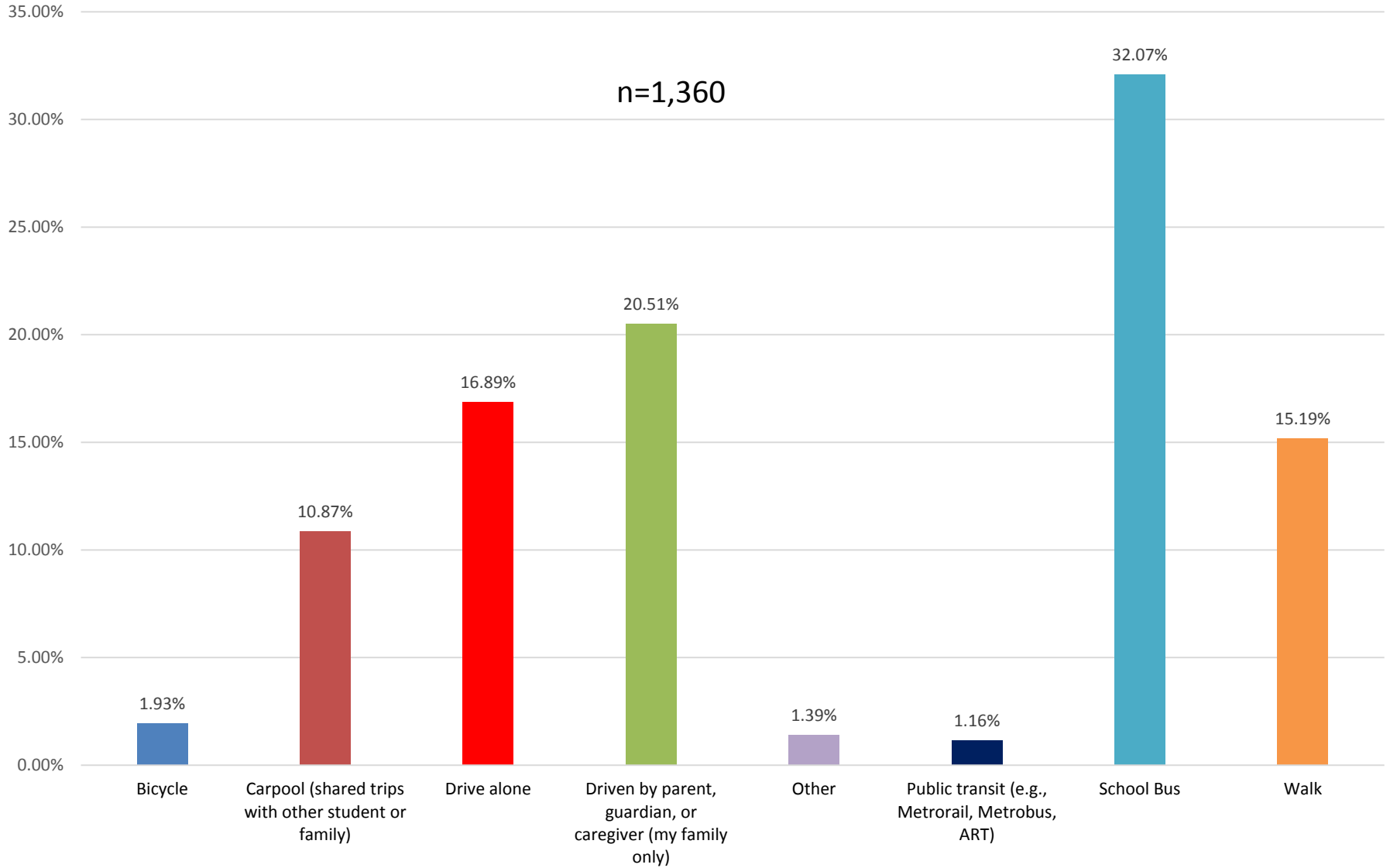
Where Does Walking Occur?

Primary Mode of Access for 11th & 12th



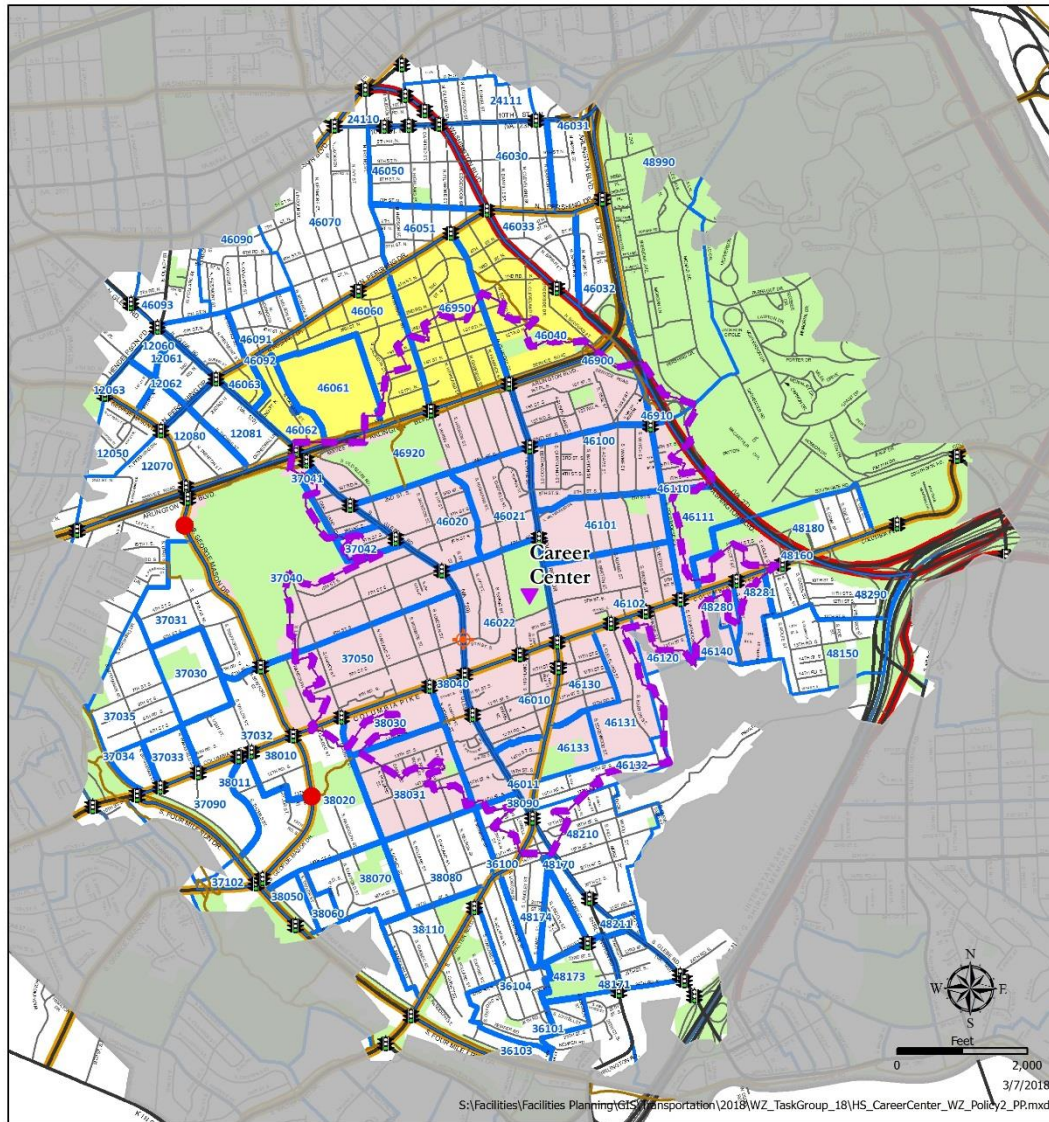


Walk Zones – Past, Present and Future
