New School at Wilson

The building has 7 floors of instructional space:

- Basement: Black Box and Classrooms
- Ground and First Floors:
 - Classrooms
 - Drama Department
 - Administrative Spaces
 - Gyms
 - Art Department
 - Clinic
 - Cafeteria
 - Theater
- Second Floor: Classrooms and Library
- Third Floor: Classrooms and Music Department
- Fourth Floor: Classrooms
- Fifth Floor: Classrooms



Space

- There are many shared spaces throughout the building including: cafeteria, clinic, library, classrooms, sensory cottage and gyms
- There are entrances distributed throughout the building on the ground and first floors. All entrances are for all students.
- The decision to place the majority of Stratford learning spaces on the ground and first floors is for egress access and student safety.
