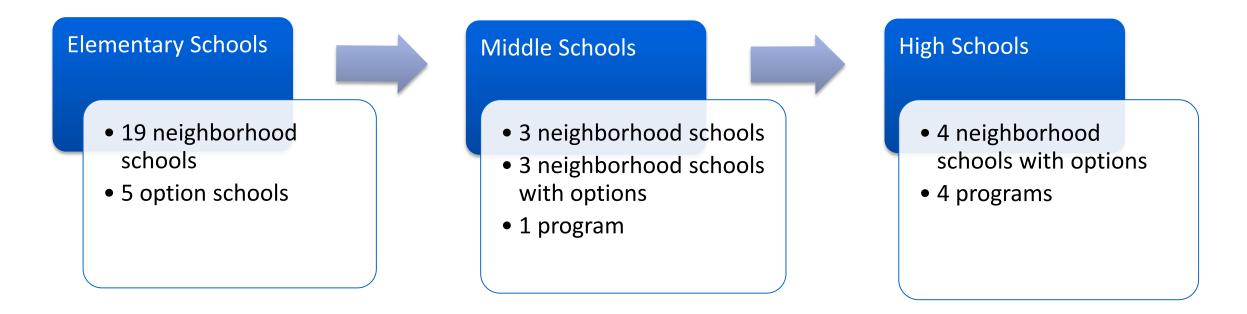

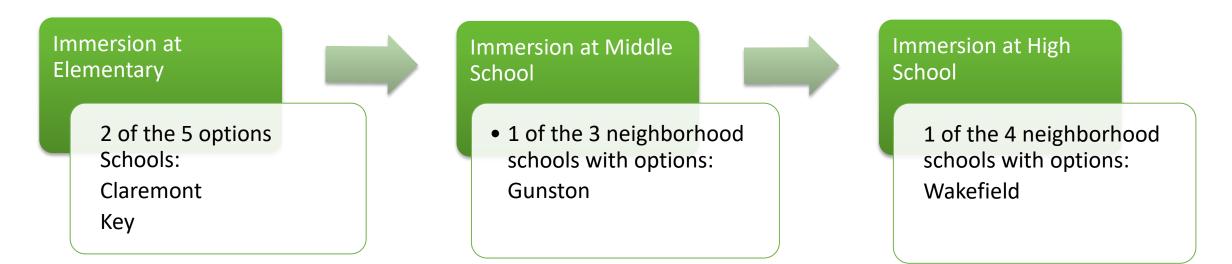

Enrollment Growth Needs for the 2019-28 CIP

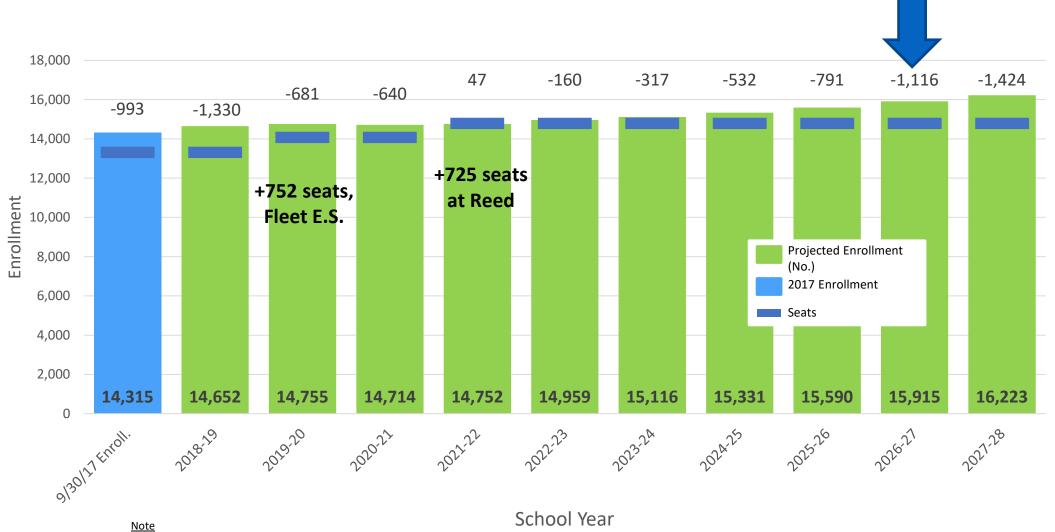

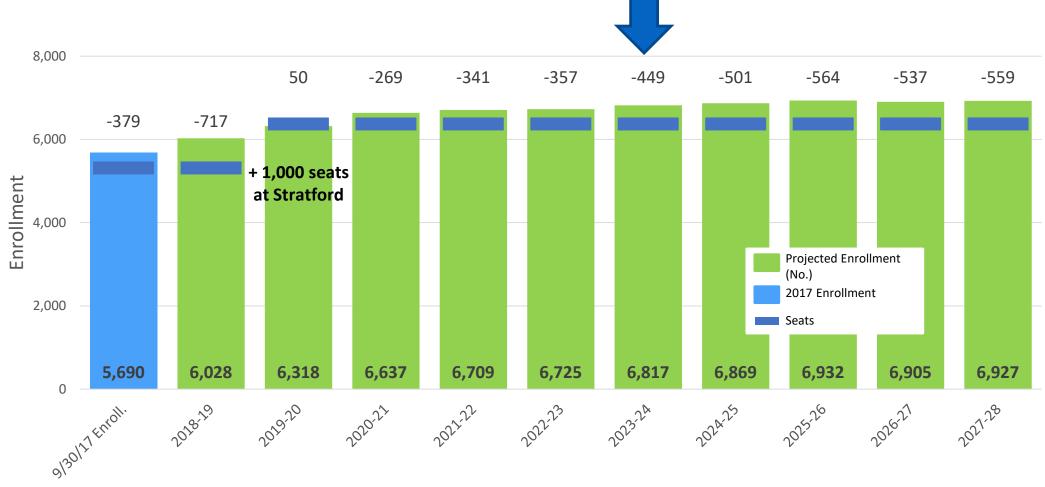

Middle School Enrollment Projections

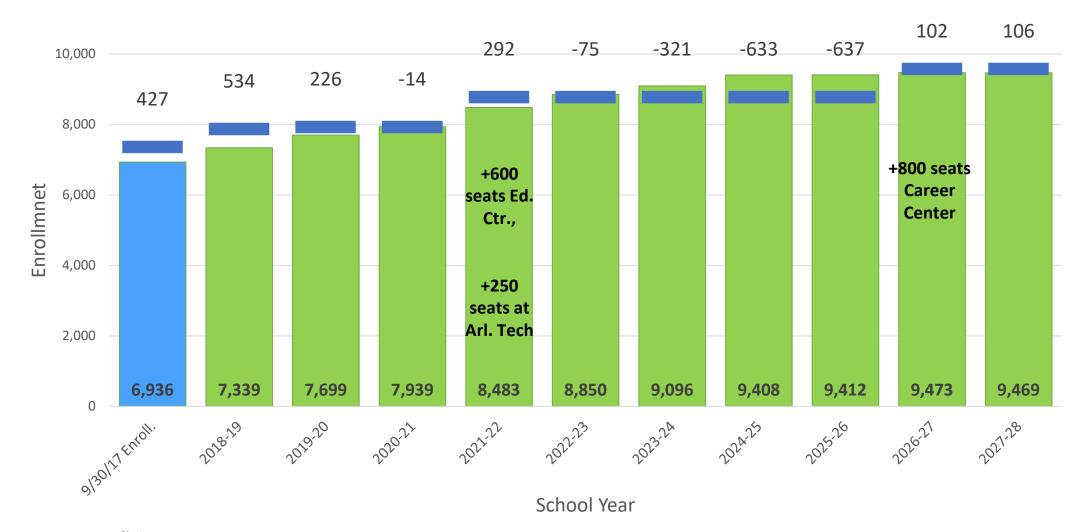
