## **Budget Discussion**

Leslie Peterson updated the Board on the reserve funding available and she spoke about the County's one-time transfer of \$367,234. Ms. Apostolico-Buck spoke about the Foreign Language in the Elementary Schools Program (FLES) and provided insight into how school administrators allocate staffing to meet the needs of the students.

The Board discussed the allocation of the County's one-time funding. They also talked about class size, employee compensation, parental leave, need for additional psychologists and changes to FLES.

## FY 2019-28 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP)

Mr. Ruiz began the work session by providing a background on enrollment, projected student growth and the overall CIP process. Mr. Chadwick followed by presenting potential capital projects recommendations to increase seats at each school level. Then, Ms. Peterson detailed the debt service ratio, bonding capacity and funding for projects. Lastly, Ms. Mimberg spoke about the community engagement process.

The Board discussed the Career Center and Education Center site and the need for additional facility space, enrollment projections, possible financial implications, analysis of facilities to maximize

building utilization, possible use of commercial sites, community communications, and reviewed student seats needed and its deficit by levels.
