**Arlington County Proposed FY 2019-2028 Capital Improvement Plan**

Mr. Schwartz presented the County Manager’s Proposed FY 2019-2028 Capital Improvement Plan which included an overview of the Arlington County capital priorities and needs, funding and community engagement.

The Boards spoke about collaboration and expressed their interest to continue to work to find solutions for field and land use.

**Arlington Public Schools FY 2019-2028 Capital Improvement Plan**

Dr. Kanninen began by summarizing projects that have been completed to highlight how APS is working efficiently to accommodate student seats. Ms. Stengle presented the FY 2019-2028 Capital Improvement Plan. She spoke about projections and summarized the proposed scenarios including Scenario A1. Dr. Natrass spoke about the possible instructional focus and Ms. Peterson presented the funding and financial implications related to the proposed Scenario A1.

The Boards conversed about capacity and student enrollment growth. The Boards took turns clarifying questions and concerns related to the proposed CIPs. They also discussed future facility and land needs for the school system.
