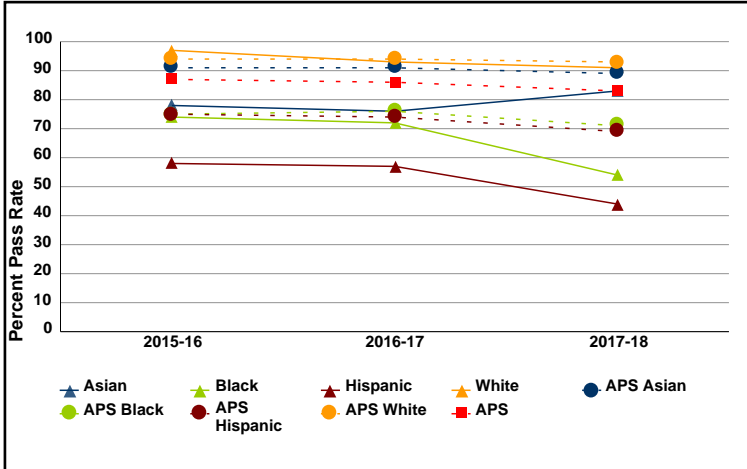

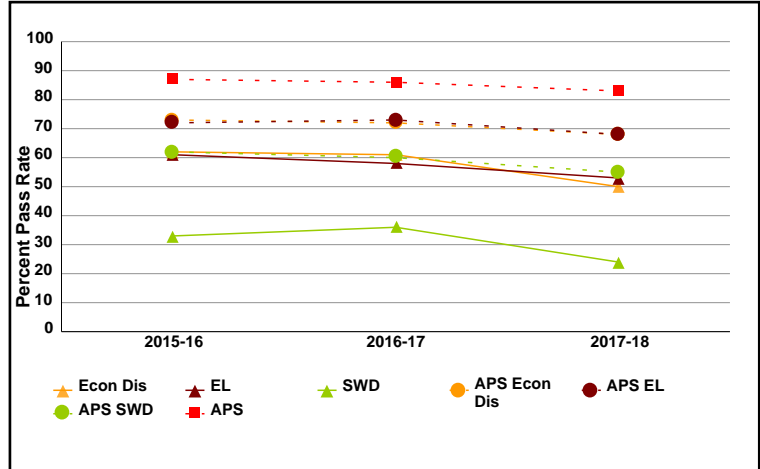

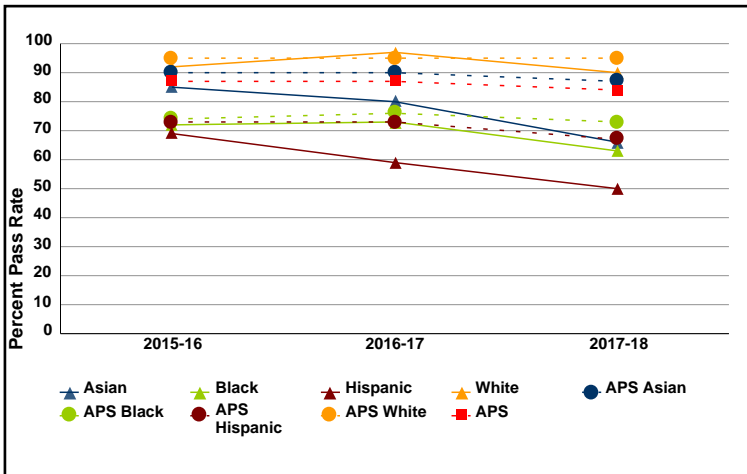
Math SOL Performance Race / Ethnicity



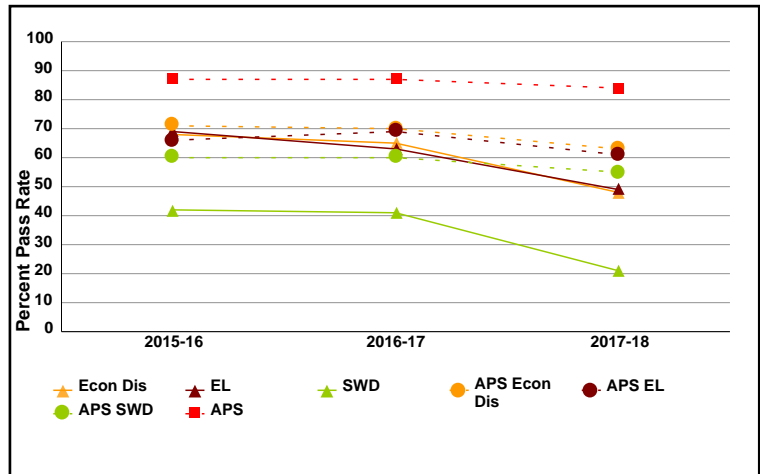
Math SOL Performance Econ.Dis. / SWD / EL



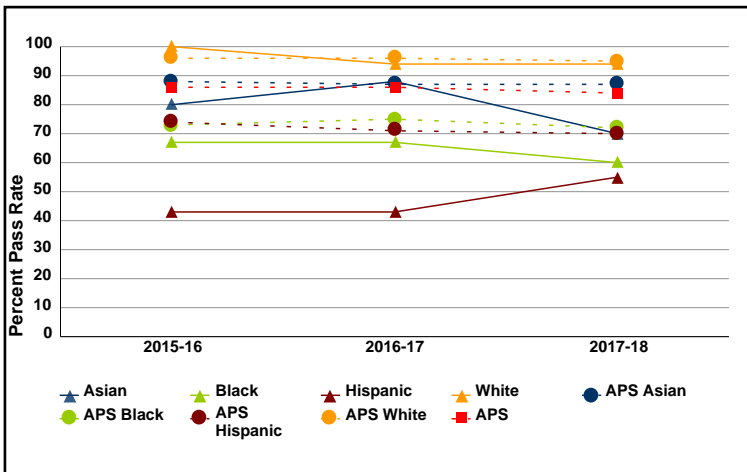
Reading SOL Performance Race / Ethnicity



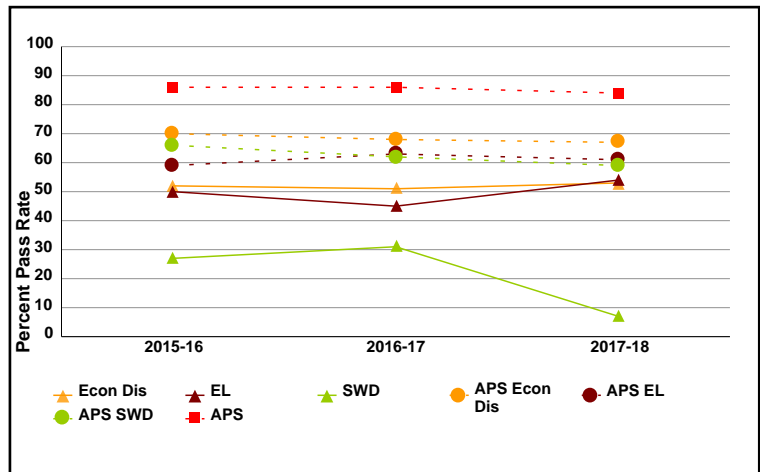

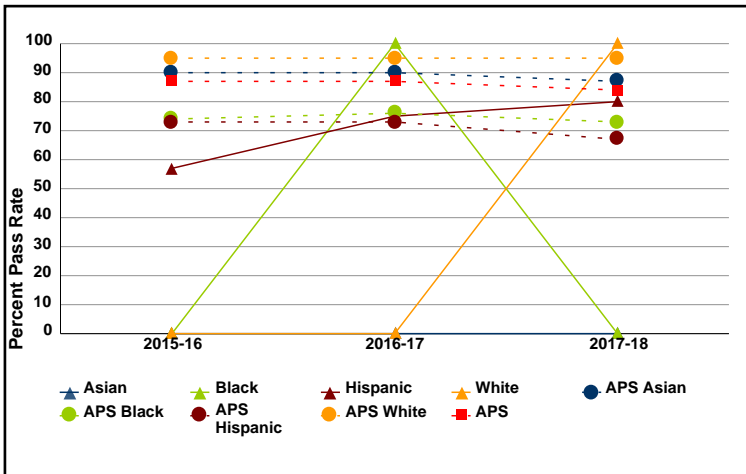
Math SOL Performance Race / Ethnicity



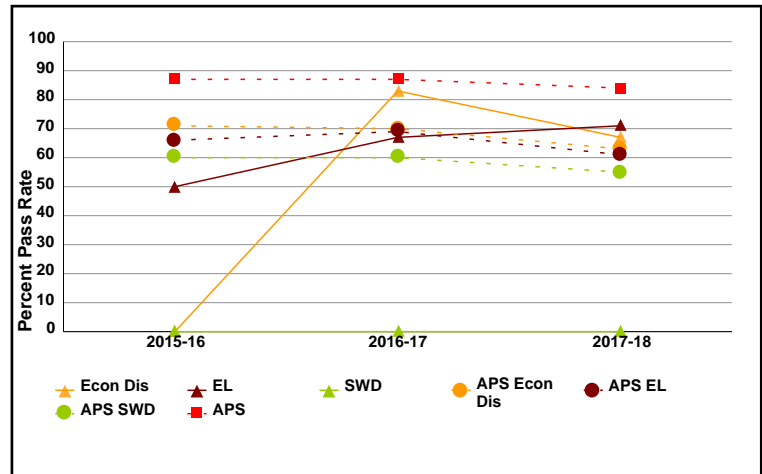

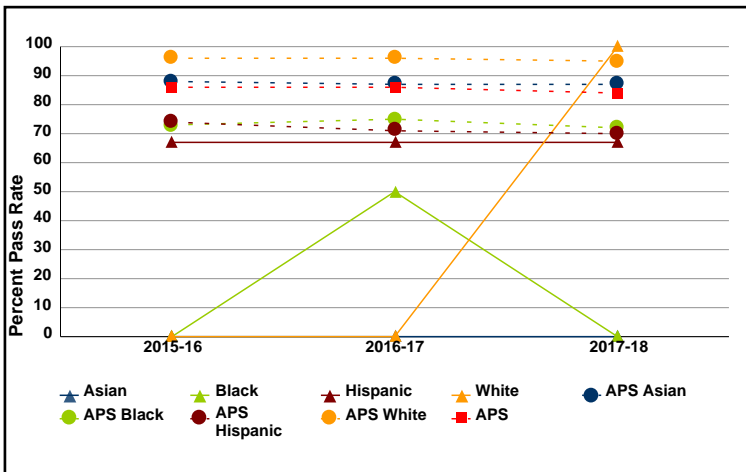
Reading SOL Performance Race / Ethnicity



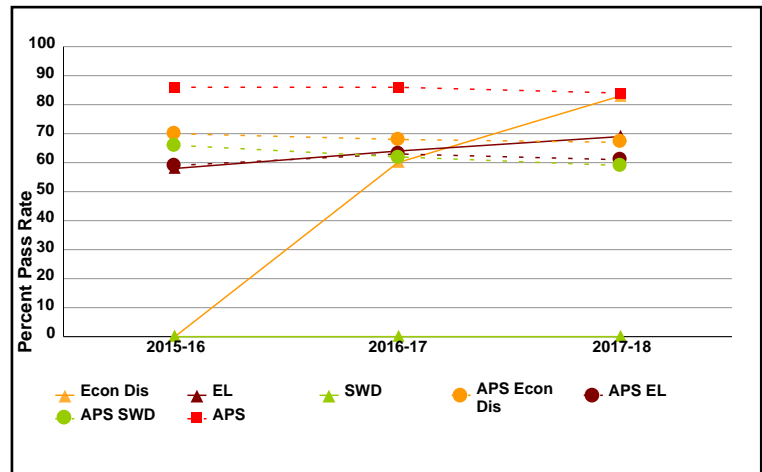

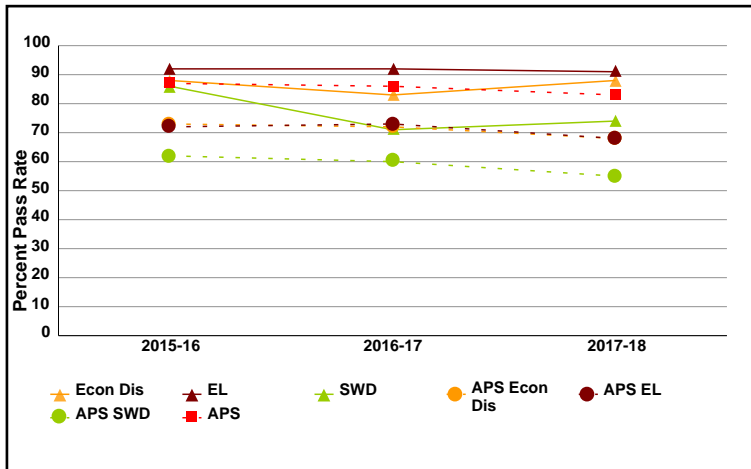

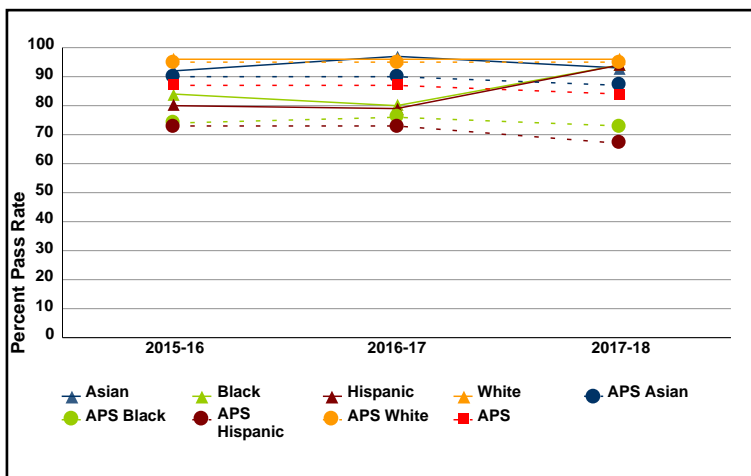
Math SOL Performance Race / Ethnicity



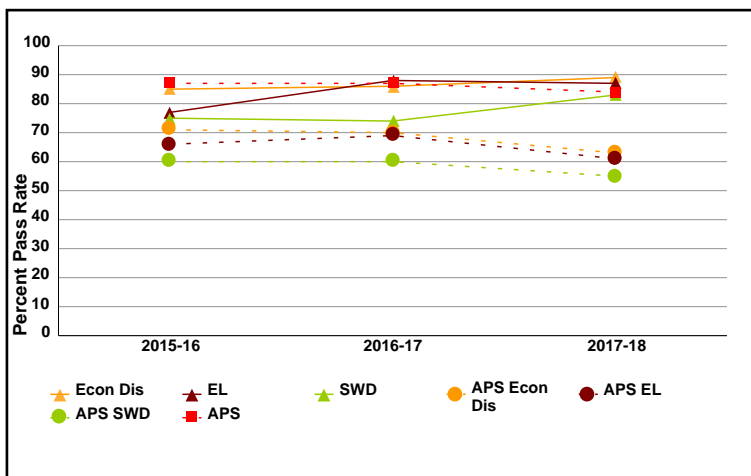

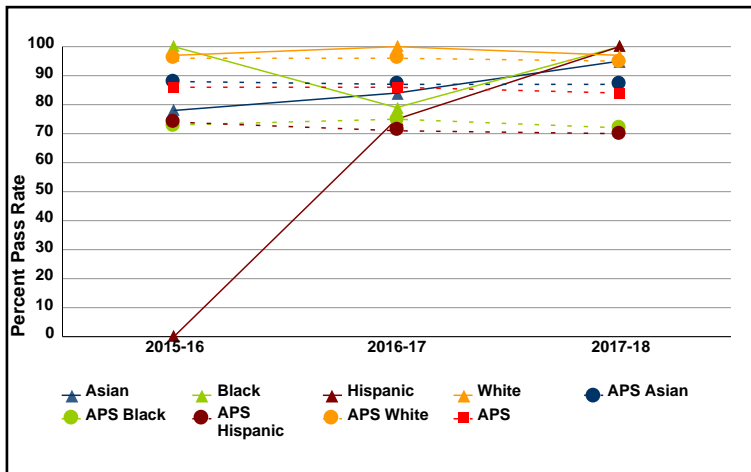
Reading SOL Performance Race / Ethnicity



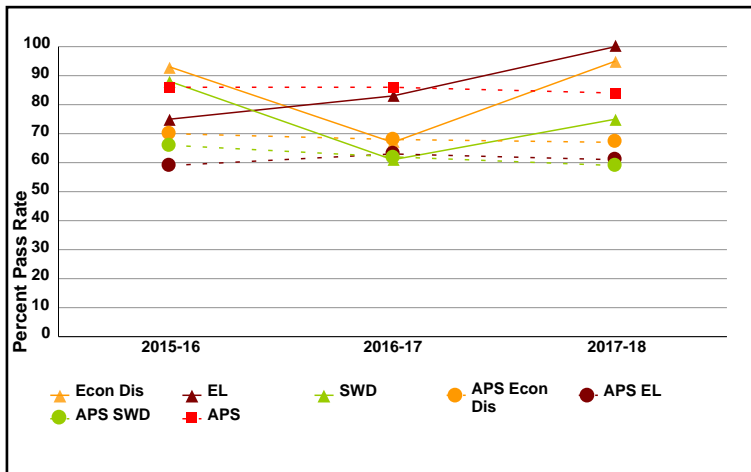

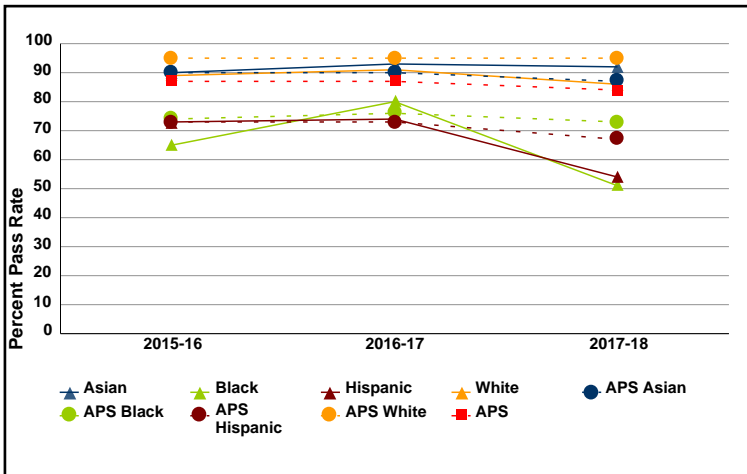
Math SOL Performance Race / Ethnicity



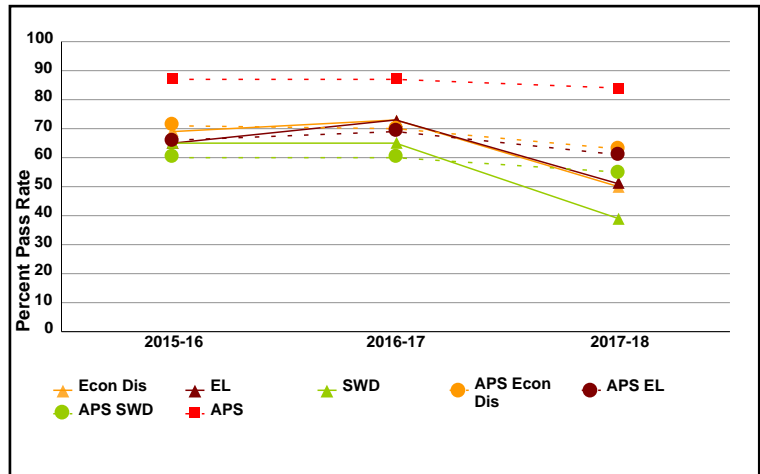

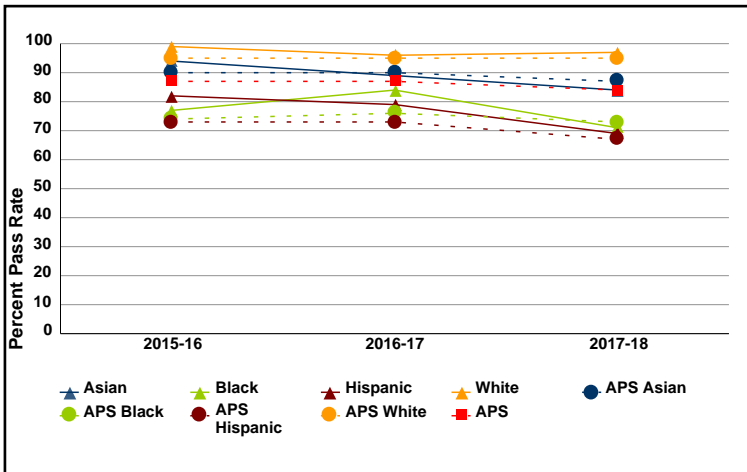
Math SOL Performance Race / Ethnicity



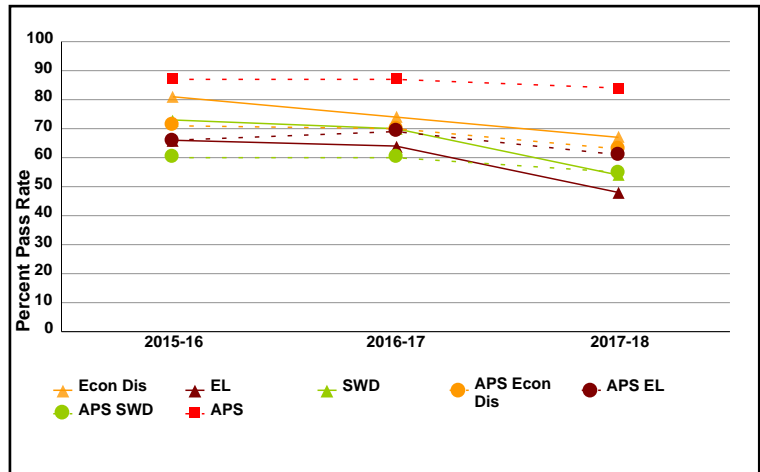

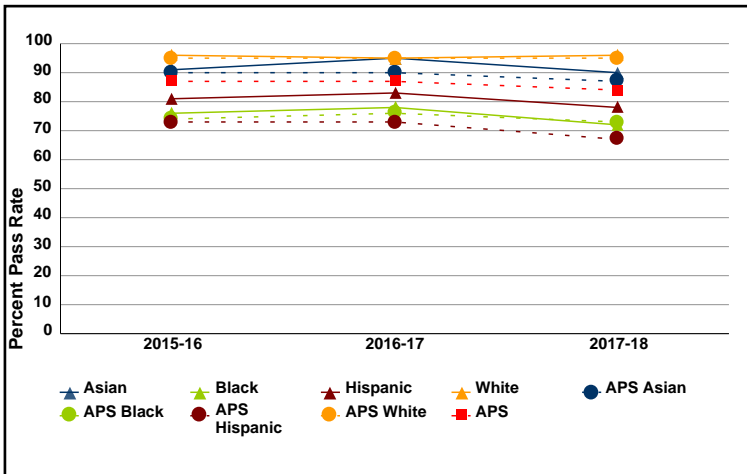
Math SOL Performance Race / Ethnicity



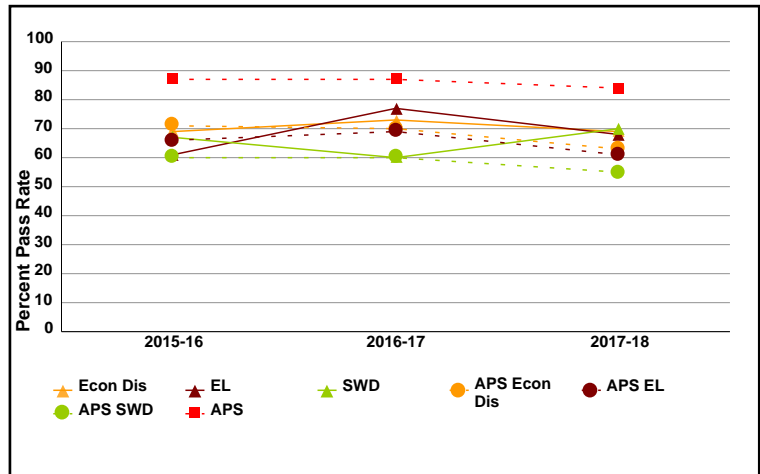

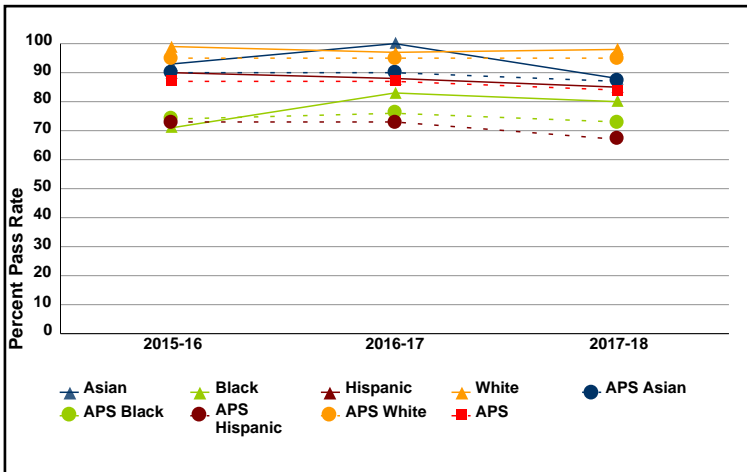
Math SOL Performance Race / Ethnicity



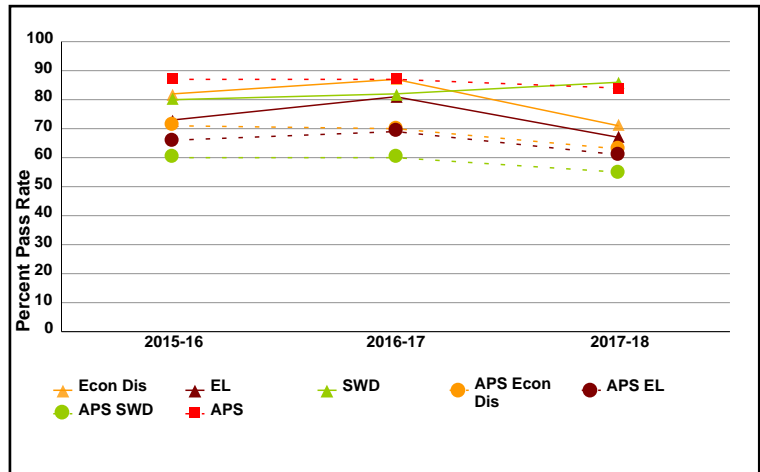

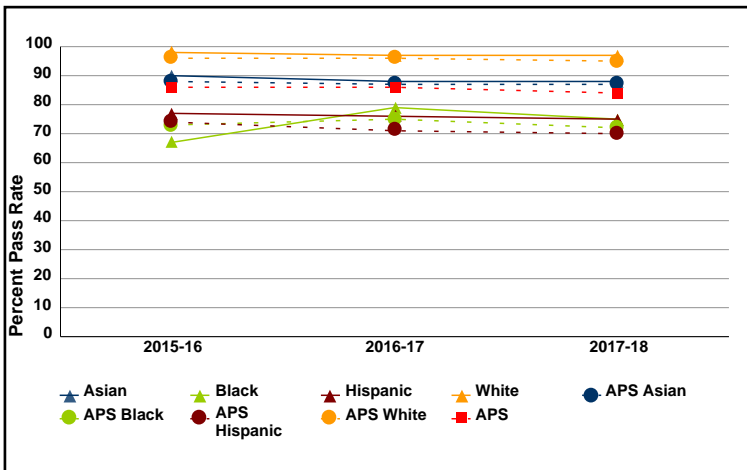
Reading SOL Performance Race / Ethnicity
