

Summary for ACI Meeting – October 3, 2018

Dr. Kelly Krug, Supervisor, ATSS, discussed a project to streamline the system of supports available to APS students. There will be information sessions and opportunities for public feedback this Fall. Once approved, the goal is to implement any changes in time for the 2019-2020 school year.

Darryl Joyner, Instructional Technology Integration Analyst, discussed the pending external evaluation of the 1-to-1 device program. Evaluation criteria are to be finalized in October 2018 and the results of the evaluation would be submitted in January 2019.

Sarah Putnam, Director of Curriculum and Instruction, outlined plans to develop K-12 Instructional Pathways. These are intended to inform the choice of instructional focus at new schools coming online next year. ACI will review and give feedback on a draft proposal this January. There will be other opportunities for community feedback this Winter.

ACI will meet again on Oct 17 to review the first round of sub-committee recommendations to the School Board.
