Through reading, stories, activities and conversation, participants learn to work effectively in cross-cultural situations. These conversations encourage a basic understanding of racism, institutional racism, White privilege, the roots of racism, and its modern manifestations around us. Each of the 11 sessions builds concrete skills of listening and practicing difficult conversations related to race, second language and other forms of bias.

Claremont and Jamestown parents are especially encouraged to take part in Challenging Racism: Learning How because it is hosted by, and at, those schools. (However, applying is NOT limited to Claremont or Jamestown parents. All APS Parents and Arlington adults are welcome to apply.)
