Fall 2018 Elementary Boundary Process Public Hearing November 27, 2018

The Arlington School Board convened on Tuesday, November 27, 2018, at 7:02 PM at 2110 Washington Blvd, Arlington, Virginia.

A. CALL TO ORDER AND CLOSED MEETING

Mr. Goldstein moved that the Board immediately convene to discuss plans related to the security of a public facility and the safety of persons using such facility, as authorized by Virginia Code §2.2-3711(A)(19), seconded by Dr. Kanninen. The motion was adopted in a vote of 4 - 0, with Mr. Goldstein, Dr. Kanninen, Ms. Talento, and Ms. Van Doren voting affirmatively. Ms. O'Grady was not present at the vote.

Mr. Goldstein moved to certify that to the best of his knowledge only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting and only such public business matters that were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered. The motion was seconded by Ms. Van Doren and was adopted in a vote of 4-0. The voting record is as follows: Mr. Goldstein – Aye; Dr. Kanninen – Aye; Ms. O'Grady – Aye; Ms. Talento – Aye; and Ms. Van Doren – Aye.

Mr. Goldstein called for a recess, and the Board reconvened in open session at 7:05 PM.

Before the Public Hearing on Elementary Boundaries begun, Ms. Stengle reviewed proposal map #6 and presented the Board with proposal map #6-1. She spoke about the recommended

planning units slated to change and she reviewed the different policy considerations for the proposals. Mr. Goldstein reminded the community that Board members are carefully weighing options and are working hard to find a boundary solution that will most benefit the school system.
