 - The group considered the revisions to these five policies, as well as information gathered from the Virginia School Boards Association and other sources in response to subcommittee questions. After review, the policies were approved to be shared with the other Board members and presented at the March 28 School Board meeting for information.
- 2. 1st Review: Revisions to B-6 Policy and Policy Implementation Procedures, B-6.3 Policies, C-8 Policy Monitoring; and proposed new policies B-6.3.30 Creation or Modification of Policies, B-6.3.31 Policy Interpretation and Waivers, B-6.3.32 Policy Monitoring, and B-6.3.33 Policy Classification

The subcommittee provided input and asked that these policies be incorporated into a single policy to be considered at the next subcommittee meeting.
