



WHAT IS A CHARRETTE?

- A collaborative session in which a group of designers drafts a <u>solution to a design</u> <u>problem</u>.
- Often take place in multiple sessions in which the group divides into sub-groups.
- Each sub-group then presents its work to the full group as <u>material for further</u> <u>dialogue</u>.





- How will proposed massing relate to ACC's phasing strategy? Hint: Think... CCWG Zoning Recommendations, Sensibility to Existing Building




