

## "What-If" Scenario: Immersion to Barrett

(for discussion purposes)

This map depicts a hypothetical scenario if only Proximity and Efficiency are prioritized and immersion moves from Key to Barrett

## Notes:

- Creates boundary for Reed
- Places ASF in its own boundary
- Key becomes a neighborhood school
- McKinley neighborhood school moves to Reed building, ATS program moves to McKinley building
- Immersion moves from Key to Barrett
- Six possible option sites (ATS, McKinley, Campbell, Claremont, Montessori, Barrett)



## **Observations:**

- Walk zones mostly adhered to
- Contiguous boundaries
- Two neighborhood schools in Rosslyn-Ballston corridor
- Barrett "absorbed" by Fleet,
  Barcroft, and Ashlawn
- Range for F/RL is 3% 100%
- Range for capacity utilization is 81% - 101%
