



Life expectancy for people living in North Rosslyn and Aurora Highlands is 88 years while its only 78 for people living in Buckingham.*





Achievement Gap: 3rd Grade Math


Mathematics 3 SOL Proficient and Advanced Pass Rates by Ethnicity, 2014-15 through 2018-19


Achievement Gap: 6th Grade Reading


6th Grade Reading SOL Pass Rates by Student Groups, 2017-18

Disparities in Discipline






Black students are just 11% of the student body but 35% of the students with suspensions.


Disparities in Mental Health



At Carlin Springs Elementary, 81% of students are eligible for free or reduced lunch.








The percent of children living in poverty is up to 5 TIMES HIGHER in certain neighborhoods


