2021-22 Calendar Development Process

One calendar option was developed for consideration

Calendar Committee met in September Calendar option was presented to Community for feedback on the overall calendar Feedback was provided to the Calendar Committee, Superintendent, and Executive Leadership Team A second option was developed incorporating feedback

Recommendations presented to School Board for decision and adoption

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Calendar Requirements and Considerations



Calendar Requirements

- 1. Develop one district-wide "Division Calendar"
- 2. Align three unique calendars to "Division Calendar"
 - Arlington Community High School and Langston High School Continuation Program (Semester Dates)
 - HB Woodlawn and Shriver Program Calendar (Early Release Dates)
 - Barcroft Elementary School Calendar (Modified Schedule)
- 3. Incorporate Summer School Calendar



Calendar Requirements

- 1. VA Code § 22.1-79.1: Opening School Year
- 2. Students Instructional Days:
 - 180 days (all levels) / 990 hours
- 3. Teacher Work Days:
 - 200 contract days required
 - 194 reporting days (Historical) 191 with three floating days during FY 2021
- 4. Recognized School Board and holidays outlined in Policy Implementation Procedure G-1.32 PIP-1 Holidays
 - Additional holidays proposed to be recognized this year



Calendar Considerations

- 1. Consideration to surrounding school division calendars
 - Winter Break
 - Spring Break
- 2. Consideration for Election Day Bill
 - Virginia House of Delegates considered a bill requiring public schools to treat election day as a student holiday (may return)
 - Currently a teacher grade prep day with telework

Veterans' Day – Nov 11 (Loudoun full day, FCPS full day, PWCS - holiday)





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Key Features

- Key features
 - Four additional cultural/religious holidays
 - Two full-days for parent-teacher conferences
 - Earlier start date (August 23 aligned with FCPS)
 - Rename Columbus Day as Indigenous Peoples' Day
 - 2 "Floating Days" for T-scale employees

Additional Holidays	Appreciation for having holidays, contrasted with concern about adding holidays (staff, students, parents and community) Concerns about increased number of shortened weeks (parents) Concerns around childcare for the days off from school (parents) There are holidays for other cultural or religious groups not listed (staff and parents) Concerns around AP/IB testing on Eid Al-Fitr (staff, parents) Align with federal holidays working families follow (parents) Split over Veterans' Day (Staff and parents) Consider Buddhist holidays (students)



Other feedback	Coordinate with surrounding jurisdictions to support APS employees who do not live in Arlington (staff) Limit or eliminate mid-week days off (staff) Consider continuing virtual/asynchronous days for learning (Staff, parents) Split on October PL day (staff) Consider week at Thanksgiving (staff, parents) November schedule is problematic (parents) Develop calendar two years in advance for planning purposes (parents) Consider more models that include year-round with more frequent breaks (parents) Spring Break is too late – disconnect from Easter/ Other jurisdictions (staff)

Students do not attend school on Parent Teacher Conferences (++/+++), and Grade Preparation Days (GP)

- •Professional Learning Early Release Elementary, Middle and High School: September __, November __, December __, February __, March __
- Elementary Teacher Records/Closeout Day: Early Release Days on June __ and June __
 October is a student holiday and a workday for all APS staff
- •12-month employees will have December __ as a holiday



Key Features in Option Two

- Start one week later than original draft
 - August 23 ten-month employees
 - August 30 K-12 students
- Move parent teacher conferences to one full conference day and one early release day
- Use hours past 990 to comply with instructional time requirements
- Longer pre-service and additional floating days
- Two floating days for PL (plus one for compliance)
- Floating day for parent-teacher conferences at Elementary, PL related to DOJ settlement at secondary



Alignment with Neighboring Jurisdictions

- Winter Break
- Spring Break
- End Dates
- Recognition of additional holidays (FCPS, Loudoun):
 - Rosh Hashanah
 - Yom Kippur
 - Diwali
 - Eid Al-fitr
- Uses hours to make required time, rather than days



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
