



Grandfathering Status Form for All Grade 4 Students Based on Fall 2020 Elementary School Boundary Process

Students currently in Grade 4 (who will be in Grade 5 in the 2021-22 school year)

On December 3, 2020, the School Board approved elementary school boundary adjustments, effective for the 2021-22 school year:

As part of this process, the School Board adopted a grandfathering provision for students who will be in Grade 5 in school year 2021-22. The grandfathering provision allows students who will be in Grade 5 in 2021-22 (this school year's Grade 4 students), who were enrolled in APS as of Dec. 7, 2020, to remain at their current school. (For McKinley students, the grandfathering provision is to attend McKinley at the Reed site in the 2021-22 school year.) Students eligible for grandfathering who choose to remain at their current school for school year 2021-22 are not eligible to receive APS transportation.
