Key may be problematic if current Key School keeps its name. <u>Jazmynn</u> - ASFS teachers prefer themes over people, must be explained to kids, leaning toward location names personally. Christine - ASFS students shared cute, fun names, where they live, "Lion" Village, space-related names, Grace Hopper buried at Arlington Cemetery. Christine is excited about her, she was a professor, scientist and computer programmer and Navy Admiral. Lived and died in Arlington, great girl power example, how far she went in the Navy. She's overlooked and underrepresented. Mascot: grasshopper. Many ASFS families are military families. Clarendon, like place names, Odyssey, Voyager and Endeavor. The name Cardinal sounds religious. Does not like name Courthouse.
