Distance Learning (DL) Task Force



- Composed of 75 stakeholders
 - Teachers, students, administrators, ITC's, Student Services staff, DTL supervisors and specialists, parents, members of advisory committees
- Met for six weeks (Jan. 6-Feb. 17)
- Focused on developing strategies and solutions to support students' academic and social-emotional growth while participating in distance learning
- Focus areas:
 - DL Focus Group feedback
 - ACTL DL Progress Reports
 - Possible disparities in experiences of students in distance learning and in-person learning
 - Use of Canvas and Microsoft Teams



DL Task Force Key Takeaways



- Need for consistent use of Canvas (common home page and module templates used within each school, consistent access to assignments)
- Microsoft Teams need regular access to breakout rooms, private communication between teacher and student to access help, students' consistent use of cameras
- Develop a shared sense of classroom community between DL and in-person students
- DL students need access to supplies, resources and hard copies of materials
- Ensure that DL students can actively engage with in-person classmates in concurrent model
