# School Board Public Hearing on the Superintendent's Proposed FY 2022 Budget March 23, 2021

The Arlington School Board convened on Tuesday, March 23, 2021 at 8:19 PM at 2110 Washington Blvd., Arlington, Virginia.<sup>1</sup>

Ms. O'Grady called the meeting to order and reviewed the public hearing procedures and speaker guidelines.

The following speakers addressed the Board concerning compensation, asking for both a STEP and a cost-of-living adjustment (COLA), and expressing concerns about the impact of not receiving STEPs and COLAs on staff. Some speakers noted the additional work that staff is doing to maintain learning during the pandemic, and some also commented that APS salaries are falling behind other local jurisdictions:

- *Gilbert Bell*, parent: asking for more support for students and parents during virtual and hybrid learning.
- *Kip Malinosky*, teacher: opposing cuts to academic and athletic stipends in the middle schools and commenting on how important these opportunities are to students, especially vulnerable students and those who do not have the means to pursue activities outside of school.
