School Board Committee of the Whole on the Middle School and High School Program of Studies December 10, 2021

The Board and staff from the Department of Teaching and Learning (DTL) held a committee of the whole meeting to provide the Board with a better understanding of the development of the Middle School and High School Program of Studies (POS) and to discuss feedback from the Board. Staff provided an overview of the timeline and collaboration between DTL and school staff to determine what classes to include in the POS. The group discussed how pilot courses are identified and developed, efforts to include intensified courses at the middle schools, and challenges with being able to offer dual enrollment courses. Additional topics discussed were potential cost savings, the role of the Board in the development of the POS, and how to ensure the POS supports multiple pathways for success.
