<sup>4</sup> In June 2018, the Arlington School Board adopted the FY 2019-2028 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) which contains two Arlington Career Center expansion projects: 1) Creation of 250 new Arlington Tech program seats; and 2) Planning and design for 800 new high school seats. The recently completed 150-seat component of the first expansion project to increase capacity for Arlington Tech has resulted in a 900-seat capacity for the Career Center building. The adopted CIP did not include funding for any additional high school seats but the planning and design funds are being used to address the proposed 800-seat addition at the Career Center.

Includes full-time Arlington Tech, Academic Academy, HILT Institute, and PEP students. Arlington Career Center part-time students are included at their neighborhood school. The CTE programs at the Career Center serve up to 900 students, divided into three blocks, where each block provides programing space for 300 students; the CTE space has a capacity of 300 seats.

The low-end factor (500 students) implemented a 6/7th utilization factor to account for the one period a day that a room would not be occupied by students. The high-end factor (600 students) implemented 7/7th utilization factor to account for student occupancy of classrooms for all periods of the day.

<sup>6</sup> PreK SPED classes are in Integration Station as placeholders. Integration Station is housed outside of APS with community PreK partners.

\* On Dec. 3, 2020, the School Board approved an attendance zone for the new neighborhood school at the Key site; adjusted the boundary for Arlington Science Focus School; moved McKinley Elementary School to the Reed site with an adjusted attendance zone; and adjusted the boundaries to Ashlawn, ASFS, Taylor and Tuckahoe. Changes are effective for the 2021-22 school year.
