Budget Highlights

Elementary Summer School - July 6-30

- Approximately 1900 elementary students enrolled in in-person & distance learning models
- Students who are eligible:
 - All PreK students 4 years old (rising Kindergarteners who received an eligibility letter)
 - Students with disabilities who have Extended School Year (ESY) or Recovery Services on their IEP
 - Students with disabilities enrolled in countywide special education programs
 - English Learners levels 1 & 2 and Temporary English Learners
- Elementary students who will not participate but meet the criteria for additional support can access a structured, online program focused on numeracy and literacy and taught by a certified teacher

Secondary Summer School - July 6-August 6

The following students are eligible for secondary summer school:

- Seniors who need a core class to graduate
- 9th-11th graders with a D or E in mathematics and/or an E in English
- 8th grade students who need a core class to be promoted to high school
- Students with an IEP who qualify for ESY/Recovery Services or are enrolled in a countywide special education program
- English Learners levels 1-4 who have not demonstrated predicted growth

Middle & high school students who need strengthening in math, reading and English can access a self-directed, adaptive online program throughout July.

High school students can access new work for credit through Virtual Virginia and APS for Economics and Personal Finance.

2021-22 - In- Person Learning

- 5 days per week
- All classes in person with teachers present
- Normal breakfast and lunch
- In-person specials and electives
- Normal bus capacity

K-12 Virtual Learning Program

- Program enrollment:
 - Elementary - 506 students
 - Middle - 343 students
 - High - 417 students
- Dedicated APS administrator and staff focused on quality virtual learning
- Curriculum & pacing aligned with in-person instruction
- 5 days per week of synchronous, virtual instruction
- Connection with school of record - counselors, extracurricular activities, athletics
- Breakfast and lunch are free for all students at grab and go locations
