School Board Public Hearing on the School Board Proposed FY 2022-2024 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) June 10, 2021

The following speakers addressed the Board:

- *Michael Ferguson,* student: requesting full funding for the renovation of the Career Center without delay.

- *Gillian Burgess*, parent: disagreeing with the CIP public engagement process and funding of The Heights Building and the Career Center renovations.
- *Maria Romero*, parent, Arlington Career Center Grupo Hispano: encouraging the Board to fund the renovation of the Career Center to give students appropriate learning facilities.
- *Christine Brittle*, parent: supporting the renovation of the Career Center to give students appropriate learning facilities but objecting to plans to add other programs to the site to address capacity.
- *Gail Perry*, former APS teacher: encouraging more focus on equity to alleviate overcapacity issues at some schools.

Ms. O'Grady thanked the speakers for sharing their comments. She also shared a summary of correspondence received by the Board related to the proposed CIP projects.
