STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE COVERAGE

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Arlington Public Schools, like most public schools, does not provide accident insurance to cover the medical costs associated with injuries your student(s) may sustain during the school day. Therefore, we highly recommend parents consider purchasing a student accident insurance policy. Student accident insurance is not just for those without health insurance. Optional student accident insurance may serve as a secondary level of coverage for those students who are already covered under a parent or guardian's primary medical insurance plan. In such cases, the optional student accident insurance may cover expenses not paid for by primary insurance plans, such as co-pays and other out-of-pocket costs.

As a courtesy to the families of Arlington Public Schools, we are providing information on affordable student accident insurance coverage at a group rate, **between \$9** to \$93 for the entire school year, depending on the coverage plan you select. This optional commercial plan was selected by the APS Office of Risk Management after consultation with the Insurance Broker of Record for APS. Parents may enroll students through the Internet or by calling the number identified below for Young Group, Inc. Enrolling via the Internet will be accomplished by the use of a dedicated secure enrollment site for the insurance provider. Parents/Guardians may enroll their student(s) now for policies covering them from August 30, 2021 to June 17, 2022.

If students do not have medical insurance to cover them in the event of an illness or injury, coverage is available to families through the Family Access to Medical Insurance Security (FAMIS) program. FAMIS is available to families who meet certain income and other eligibility requirements. The program is sponsored by the Commonwealth of Virginia.
