

Fall 2021 Secondary School Boundary Process: Concurrent Sibling Transfers at Wakefield

December 10, 2021

Dear Wakefield Families:

The School Board voted on December 2, 2021 to adopt the Fall 2021 Boundary Adjustments that will become effective August 2022 and include the following provisions:

Planning units 46110, 46120, 46111, 48160, 48180, 48290, 46140, 48150, 48280, 48281 are reassigned from Wakefield to Washington-Liberty High School. The change applies to all current 8th grade students and all new and future incoming students who reside in the planning units listed above.

Students who are in 8th grade during school year 2021-22 and reside in one of the planning units above have the option to enroll at Wakefield for school year 2022-23 to concurrently attend the same school as an older sibling. Therefore, your 8th grade student and their older sibling(s), who are currently attending Wakefield, may attend Wakefield for grades 9-12 and APS will provide transportation for these students via Countywide hub stops.
