## Student Success

### Recommendations for SY 2022-23

- Pause the Virtual Learning Program to allow opportunity for comprehensive program planning and implementation
- Engage in program development, planning and establishment of Task Force/Committee led by current Virtual Learning Program principal to propose comprehensive framework for future Virtual Learning Option Program



## Student Success

- Students who are not able to return to in-person instruction due to their own medical condition or due to the medical condition of an individual who resides in the household full-time will be able to apply for an exemption from returning to instruction in person.
- Documentation of medical conditions must include evidence of ongoing treatment by a certified health care provider of issues related to the health of a student, or a member of the student's immediate household, that may be significantly impacted by potential exposure to COVID-19 and which could be mitigated by the student's participation in virtual learning.



## Student Success

- Eligible students will enroll in K-12 Virtual VA courses unless applying and qualifying for Homebound Instruction.
- Virtual VA courses provide core instructional courses and supplemental instructional support from a teacher and/or mentor will be provided. Students would follow Virtual VA schedules.
- Elementary Art, Music and PE would be supplemented by specifically hired APS staff.



## Student Success

- K-5 schedule is 8 a.m. – 1 p.m., four days per week
- On Wednesdays, instruction ends at 10:30 a.m. and students engage in asynchronous work

## Student Success

- **February 18** – Applications available for families to apply for medical exemption to return to in-person learning and receive Virtual Instructional Learning Services.
- **March 7** – Window to apply for medical exemption closes.\* Notification of approval of medical exemption will be communicated within two weeks of completed applications unless additional verification is required.
- **August 22** – Courses for Virtual Virginia begin.
- **August 29** – First day of school for the 2022-2023 school year.

*\*Only new students enrolling in APS will be considered after the window closes, as well as those with serious health concerns.*
