




Research-based high impact tutoring provides access to instructional support for students

Access to tutoring will remove income barriers to access high quality tutoring for students who may not otherwise be able to afford tutoring



- Live, individualized instruction for students (grades 6 -12)
- Accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Ability to provide services across multiple content areas, including advanced course work
- Ability to differentiate tutoring services based upon student needs
- Access to highly qualified tutors (licensed and/or trained instructional staff)
- Reliable and secure interface for student access
- Data on usage:
 - When are students accessing support?
 - For which courses?
 - For topics or types of questions?

ANTICIPATED OUTCOMES & IMPACT

- Students will benefit from access during the school day, after school, evenings, summer, etc.
 - "Meet students where they are"
- Students will be able to -
 - gain support in multiple subjects
 - access support on assignments from APS teachers
 - o benefit from quick refreshers or check-ins
 - o work with a tutor in small group station during class (as a supplement to learning)
- We will decrease the need for remediation that might need to occur inside/outside of school
- Educators have been working tirelessly to support students and will benefit from additional support to help students succeed.
