Percussionists who are part of the Jr. Honor Band (4-6) will be required to play various percussion parts, including (but not limited to) snare drum, bass drum, cymbals, and other auxiliary instruments. Therefore, the percussion audition will consist of two parts: Snare drum (75 points) and Mallets (25 points) Students are expected to bring mallets appropriate for each instrument. ## Part I. Snare Drum

### Concert "Buzz" Roll (15 points)

Musical notation for Concert "Buzz" Roll, 4/4 time. The piece consists of four measures, each starting with a snare drum roll. The dynamics are *pp* for the first two measures and *ff* for the last two measures.

### Flam (15 points)

Musical notation for Flam, 4/4 time. The piece consists of four measures of eighth-note patterns, each starting with a flam (a snare drum roll followed by a single eighth note).

### Prepared Selection (30 points)

Musical notation for Prepared Selection, 4/4 time. The piece consists of two staves of eighth-note patterns. The first staff has dynamics *mf* and *p*. The second staff has dynamics *f*, *mf*, and *f*.

## Part II. Mallets

### F Concert Scale (10 points)

Musical notation for F Concert Scale, 4/4 time. The piece consists of a single staff of eighth-note patterns, starting with a treble clef and a key signature of one flat.

### Prepared Piece (15 points)

#### Moderato
