Health Forms and Immunizations



Ensure your student has all required health forms and immunizations before the start of school!

New elementary students need:

- School Health Entrance Health Form
- Tuberculosis (TB)
 Screening Form

Rising 7th graders need:

- Tetanus/Diphtheria/ Pertussis (Tdap)
- Meningococcal (MenACWY)
- · First dose HPV vaccine

Rising 12th graders need:

Meningococcal (MenACWY) booster (given after age 16)

For more information, contact your school's nurse or your child's primary care physician
