Thanksgiving

Salvation Army (518 S Glebe Rd, Arlington, VA 22204)

- Thursday, Nov. 17th - 9:30am - 12pm & 1:30pm—3pm
- Thanksgiving Distribution Assistance - Arlington residents only, for families of 2 or more and adults over 65. 200 families will be served, first come first served.
- Requirements/Requisitos: Picture ID, Proof of Arlington address

Arlington Assembly of God (4501 N Pershing Dr, Arlington, VA 22203)

- Thanksgiving Day: 11am Thanksgiving service. 12:30 Meal
- A full hot meal with Turkey and all the trimmings.
- No qualification or registration necessary. Just come hungry. And bring their family.
