



## Supply List: Pastel or Oil Painting | FA307

### Oil Paints (Gamblin, Winsor Newton,)

Cadmium Yellow, Light	Cadmium Red Light
Cerulean Blue	Alizarin Crimson
Yellow Ochre	Sap Green
Naples Yellow	Burnt Umber
Ultramarine Blue or Cobalt Blue	
Burnt Sienna or Transparent Oxide Red	
Permalba white or Titanium White	

### Optional Tubes:

Cadmium Orange

### Brushes:

Assorted Bristle flats  
Long sable flats-sizes 6-12  
Sable rounds in sizes 6-12

**Minimum: 1 round sable # 2 (should be skinny like a pencil point)**

**2 flat sables #6 and #10**

**1 bristle brush #7-flat**

### Medium:

Oil painting Medium such as Liquin  
Or mix together  
1 part stand oil  
1 part demar varnish  
4-5 parts turpentine

### Canvas:

Prestretched canvases OR  
Stretch your own using pre-primed canvas  
Cotton duck-cheap  
Linen-expensive  
I do not recommend canvas boards

### Miscellaneous:

Kleenex or paper towels or old rags  
Mineral Spirits or Turpentine  
Palette

### Palette:

2 small cups, one to hold medium and the other to hold turpentine  
(clip on cups are nice)  
palette knife
