

APPENDIX C12 - Secondary Teacher Survey

Teacher surveys were administered in January and February 2023 and included closed and open-ended questions. Questions focused on use of the school library, collaboration, type of library schedule, satisfaction with the school library services and resources, level of comfort with databases, and perceptions of student skills.
