

APPENDIX C5 - Elementary Librarian Survey Results

Surveys were administered to librarians at an October 2022 meeting and included both closed and open-ended questions. Respondents reflected on various aspects of the program, including student and staff use of the school library, collaboration between librarians and other staff members, satisfaction with school library services and resources, level of comfort with databases, and perceptions of student skills.
