Modifications to the ITB:

Modification to the ITB: The following modifications are made to ITB 128FY23 through Addendum No. 1. Modification is highlighted in **red** for additions and **black** for deletions.

- Q1. What constitutes "Critical Response Service"?
 - **A1.** Critical Response Service constitutes weather or regional emergency requests has been added to the Scope of Work and Pricing Schedule (Please see changes reflected in the attached Scope of Work and Bid Form).
- **Q2.** Should a Flat Emergency Fee be added to the pricing schedule?
 - **A2.** A Flat Emergency Fee has been added to the Scope of Work and Pricing Schedule (Please see changes reflected in the attached Scope of Work and Bid Form).

Scope of Work

1. Purpose:

The Contractor shall deliver **Off Road Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel Fuel for Generators** with a maximum 15ppm low sulfur content (content <0.000015%), on an as requested basis within two (2) business days of notification for a standby delivery. Deliveries will be made to multiple fixed generators at the APS locations listed in Appendix 4. Orders will be placed via phone or by purchase order.

2. Critical Response Service:

- 2.1. The Contractor shall provide "on-call" Critical Response service (weather or regional emergency requests), twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week. The Contractor shall arrive at the job site within eight (8) hours of notification of a Critical Response service. Rates for Critical Response service will be reimbursed at the Critical Response service rate listed on Pricing Schedule. The Contractor shall provide an emergency phone number assigned to a Critical Response service callback to APS for service required after regular business hours. This number shall be monitored and responded to by the Contractor, twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week.
- 2.2. A flat Emergency Fee may be charged due to the failure of APS to place an order on a timely basis that is not a weather or regional emergency request.

3. Pricing:

- 3.1 The price of the fuel will be based on the Oil Price Information Service (OPIS) price for "Unbranded Average Fairfax, VA" weekly posting for the week the delivery occurred plus the per Gallon Delivery Charge.
- 3.2 Additional Delivery Charge: An Additional Delivery Charge will be allowed when a trip request is less than 200 gallons per trip.

4. Historical Information:

APS Total usage during 2020 to present is approximately 64,000 gallons. A chart showing dates and estimated quantities delivered is in Appendix 5.

5. Personnel:

- 5.1. The Contractor's personnel assigned to any resulting Contract shall be equipped with all tools required to perform the job.
- 5.2. The Contractor shall have sufficient tradesmen available to perform all assigned work under any resulting Contract.
- 5.3. If any person employed on the work by the Contractor shall appear to the APS Project Officer to be incompetent or to act in a disorderly or improper manner, such person shall be removed immediately on the request of the APS Project Officer and shall not again be re-employed (on subject project) except on written consent of the APS Project Officer.
 - 5.3.1. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are prohibited on the job site. Possession of any of these items on the job site by a Contractor's employee will result in immediate removal of the individual from the site.
 - 5.3.2. The use of tobacco is prohibited on APS property by anyone at any time.
- 5.4. APS reserves the right to reject any of Contractor's service personnel who, in APS' judgment, are not adequately qualified to perform the work.
- 5.5. A Contractor's vehicle parked at an APS site other than in a parking space or at on-street parking will be clearly labeled with the Contractor's name.
- 5.6. When entering any APS building, the Contractors' employees shall have picture identification. Identification shall include employees' photograph and name. The Contractor's employees are required to check-in at each location

with the Main Office or the Building Manager when reporting to the work site. Prior to leaving a site, the Contractor's employees will also be required to check-out with the Main Office and/or the APS Project Officer.

General Instructions:

The Bidder is directed to review the Bid Documents and all Contract Documents to understand the requirements for submitting a responsive Bid. All Bids must be submitted on this **Bid Form** or a copy thereof as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. All blanks in this Bid Form must be completed or noted as not applicable. A notation of "not applicable" or "N/A" shall be used only if the information requested is not a required or mandatory element of the Bid. Include only one (1) price for each line item for which a price is required. A person authorized to bind the Bidder in contractual matters must sign the Bid Form. Failure to comply with these requirements, or with any other requirements stated as mandatory either in the Invitation or in the Instructions to Bidders, shall result in rejection of the Bid as non-responsive unless, in the sole discretion of APS, the omission does not affect price, quantity, quality or time. The Owner has no authority to waive failure to comply with requirements made mandatory by applicable law.

A Bid not received prior to the Bid Closing as defined in the Invitation will not be considered. The time a Bid is received shall be determined as stated in the Invitation.

The apparent low Bidder(s) will be determined by the Bid Evaluation Total set forth in the Bid Evaluation Formula.

Payment Terms:

APS requires that a minimum of thirty (30) Days after receipt of an approved invoice by APS shall be allowed for payment. Discounts for prompt payment will not be considered in the evaluation of Bids nor in any decision to award or not to award. However, any offered discount will become part of any Contract with Bidder which may result from this solicitation and will be taken if payment is made within the discount period offered in the Bid. In connection with any discount offered for prompt payment, time shall be computed from the date of the invoice. For the purpose of earning the discount, payment shall be considered to have been made on the date that appears on the payment check or the date on which an electronic funds transfer for the payment was made. If Bidder provides a prompt payment discount, the terms thereof are as follows:

In the event multiple awards are made, no minimum percentage of the Work is guaranteed to any Contractor. When multiple awards are made, preference will be given to the Bidder submitting the lowest Bid Evaluation Total in ordering performance, subject to the reasonable discretion of APS in achieving prompt, efficient and acceptable performance.
